


Epidemiological situation

- 1st case was registered on February 29, 2020.
- 102 971 (2 328 during last 24 hours) laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases as of the reporting period.
- 161 819 (2 634 during last 24 hours) suspected COVID-19 cases as of the reporting period.
- Case positivity rate is 63.6%.
- Daily growth factor in reporting cases is 1.11 (new cases reported today/new cases reported yesterday).
- Number of lethal cases is 2 244 (37 in last 24 hours).
- Case fatality rate is 2.2%.
- Number of confirmed cases among healthcare workers is 10 367 (148 in last 24 hours).
- Total number of recovered patients is 51 735 (657 in last 24 hours).
- Average bed occupancy rate is 23.6% (lowest – in Poltavska oblast (6.0%), highest – in Ternopilska oblast (52.1%)).*
- Total number of PCR tests conducted is 1 402 242 (22 207 in last 24 hours).


Number of confirmed cases in regions

Map Legend




Confirmed cases by date of reporting, as of 22.08




Active cases per day




Active cases cumulative




Lethal and recovered cases







Latest measures of the government

- About 34,000 beds and 3,700 ventilators for patients with COVID-19 [are ready in Ukrainian hospitals](#).
- [Additional hospitals to provide care to patients with coronavirus will be deployed](#) in seven regions of Ukraine.
- The Ministry of Health has submitted its proposals to strengthen control over those who must undergo mandatory self-isolation and the number of people who have been in contact with them. [The issue of translating the application "Dii Vdoma" into English for foreign citizens coming to Ukraine from the countries of the red zone](#) is also being resolved, said the Deputy Minister of Health of Ukraine.
- [The Fund for Resisting COVID-19 provides a total of UAH 66 billion from the state budget](#), namely: UAH 16.3 billion for health care, UAH 10.6 billion for the social sphere, law enforcements - UAH 2.5 billion, economic stimulation - UAH 36 billion, partial recovery of state budget expenditures - UAH 0.5 billion, million education - UAH 52.5 million.
- An additional meeting of the State Commission for Technogenic and Ecological Safety and Emergencies, [approved a decision to review the levels of epidemic danger of the spread of COVID-19](#).
