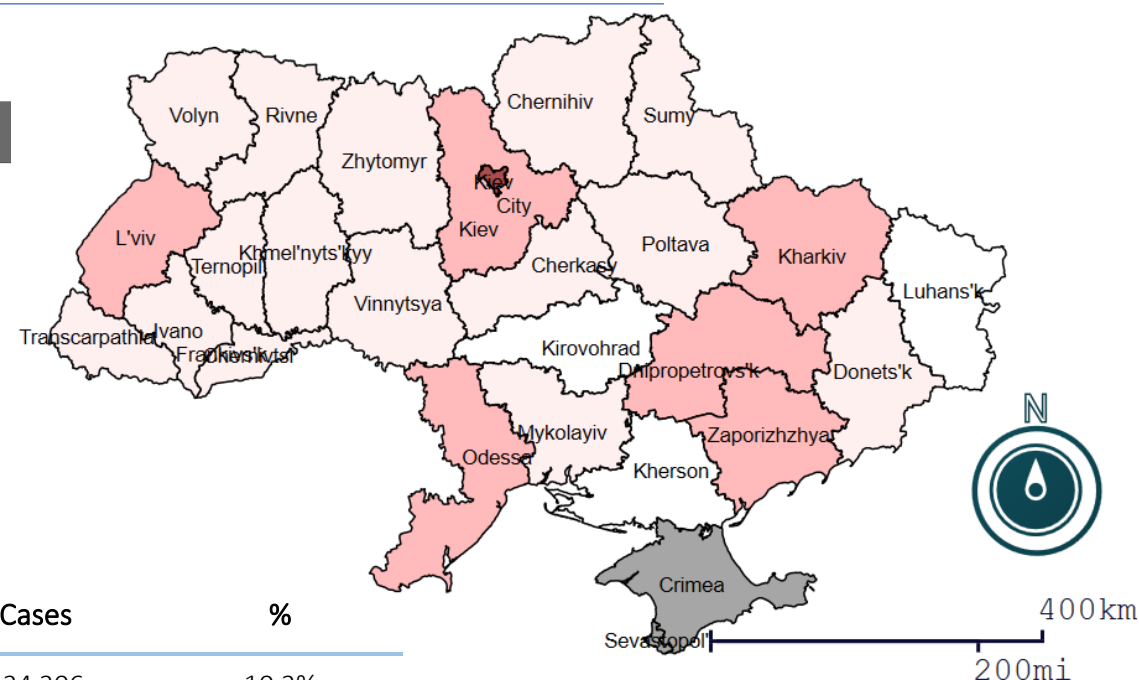
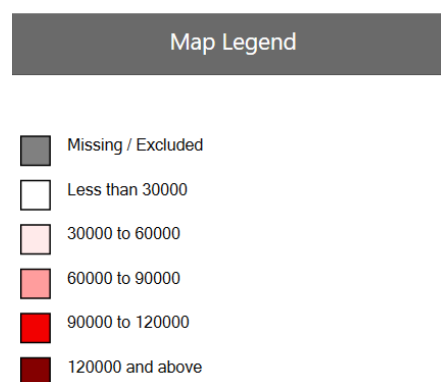

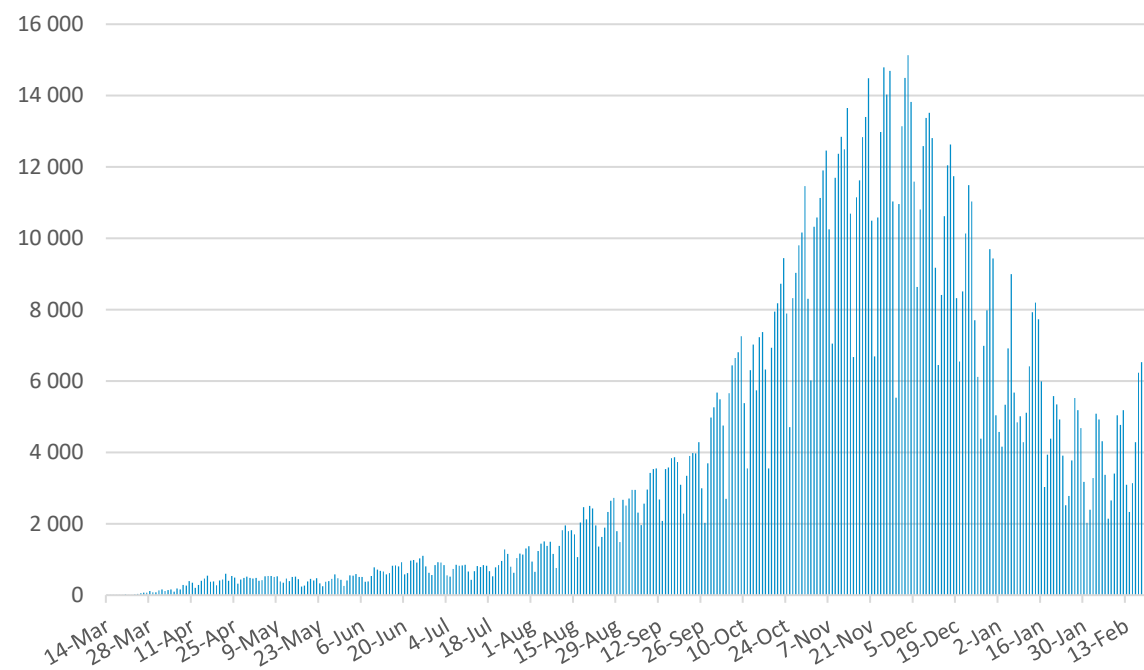

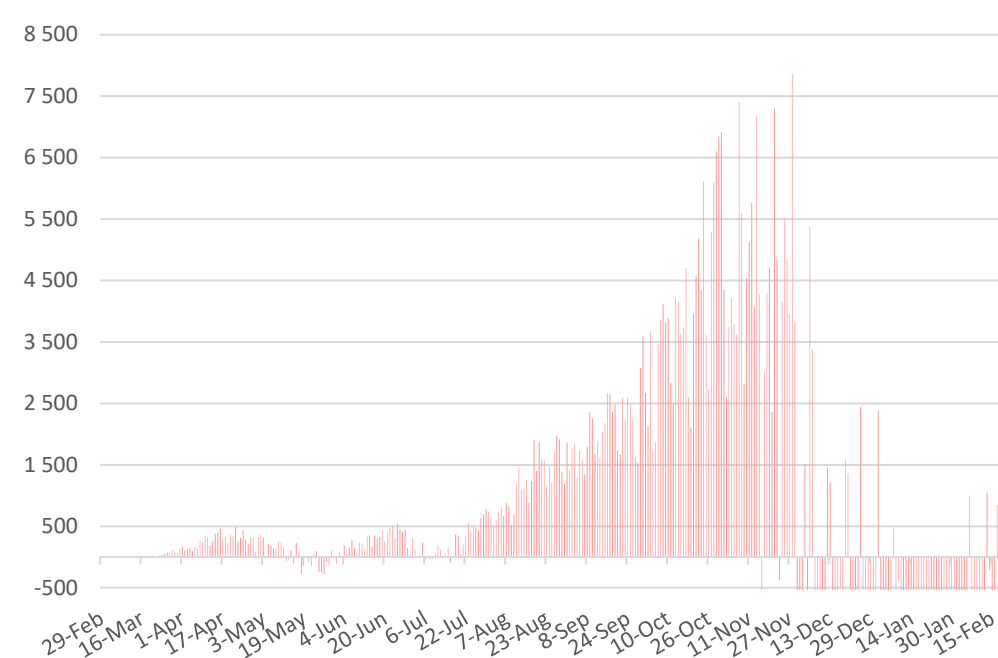

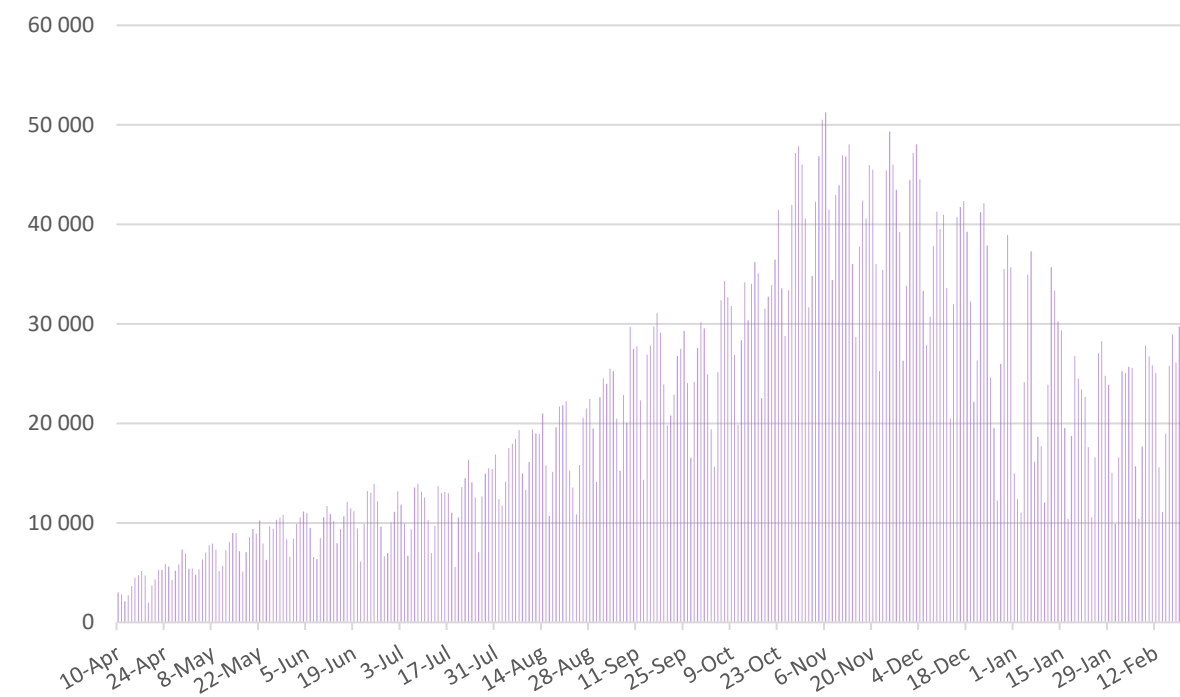
Confirmed cases by date of reporting



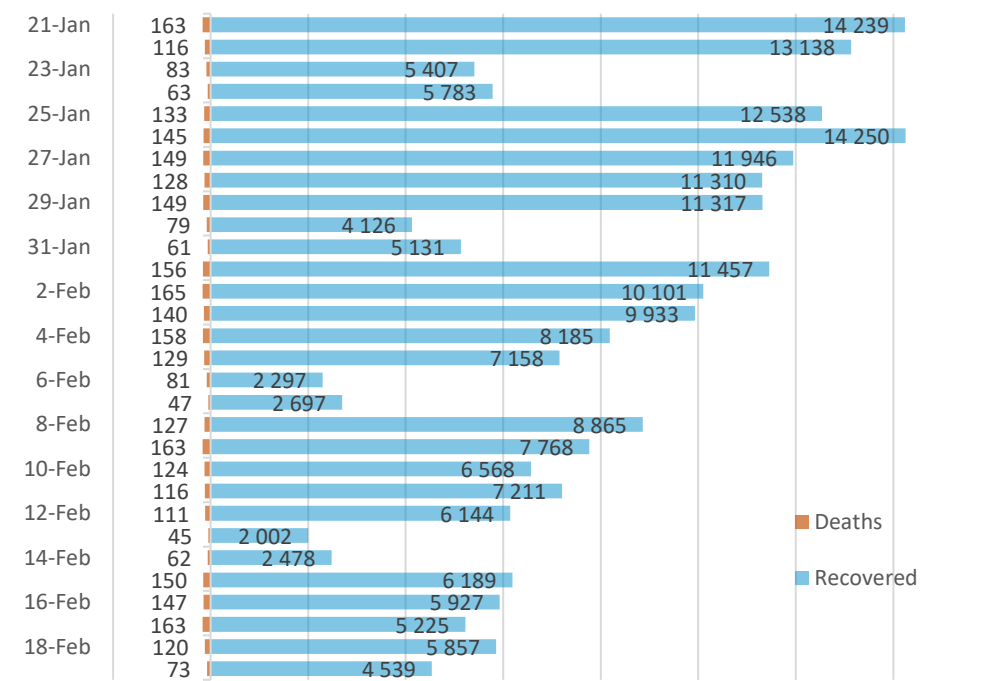
Active cases per day



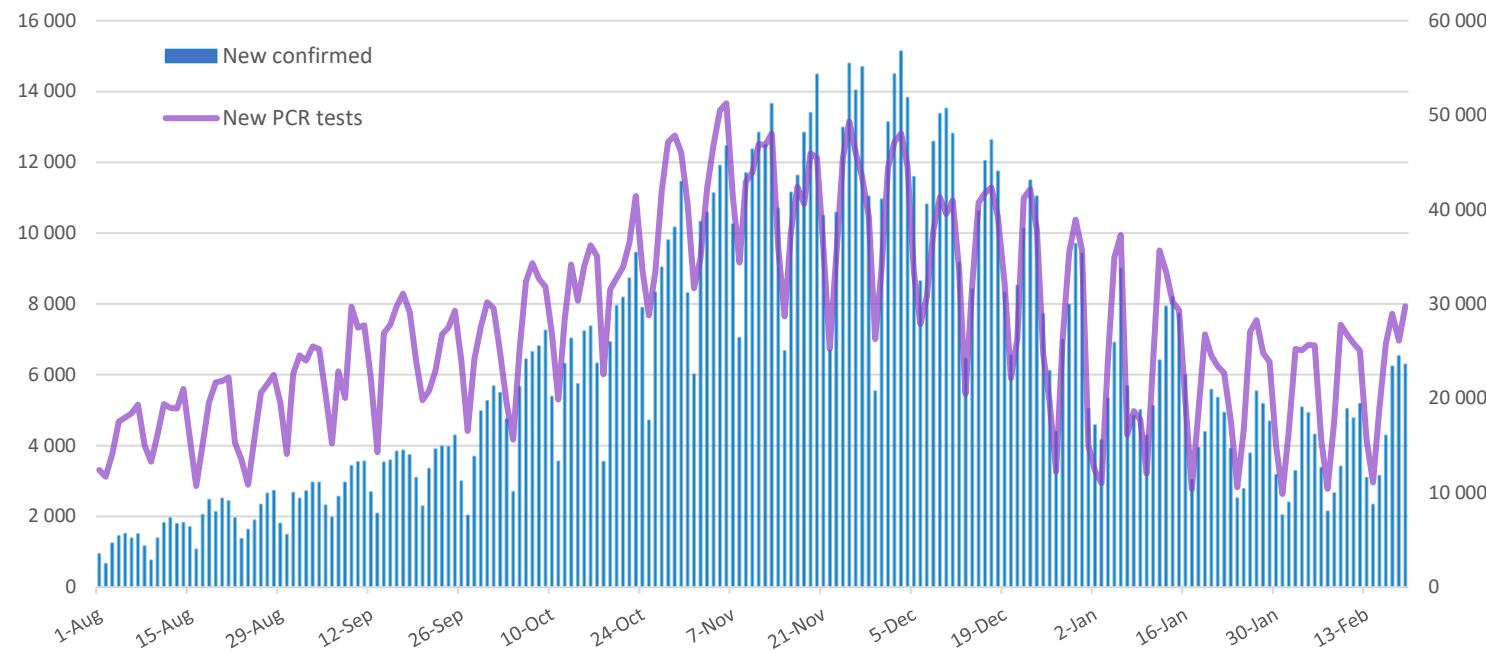
Conducted PCR tests



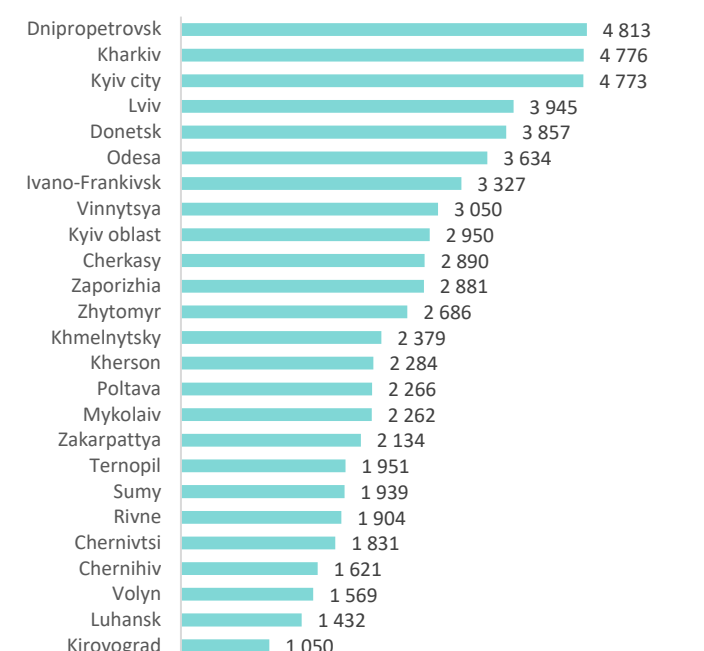
Lethal and recovered cases



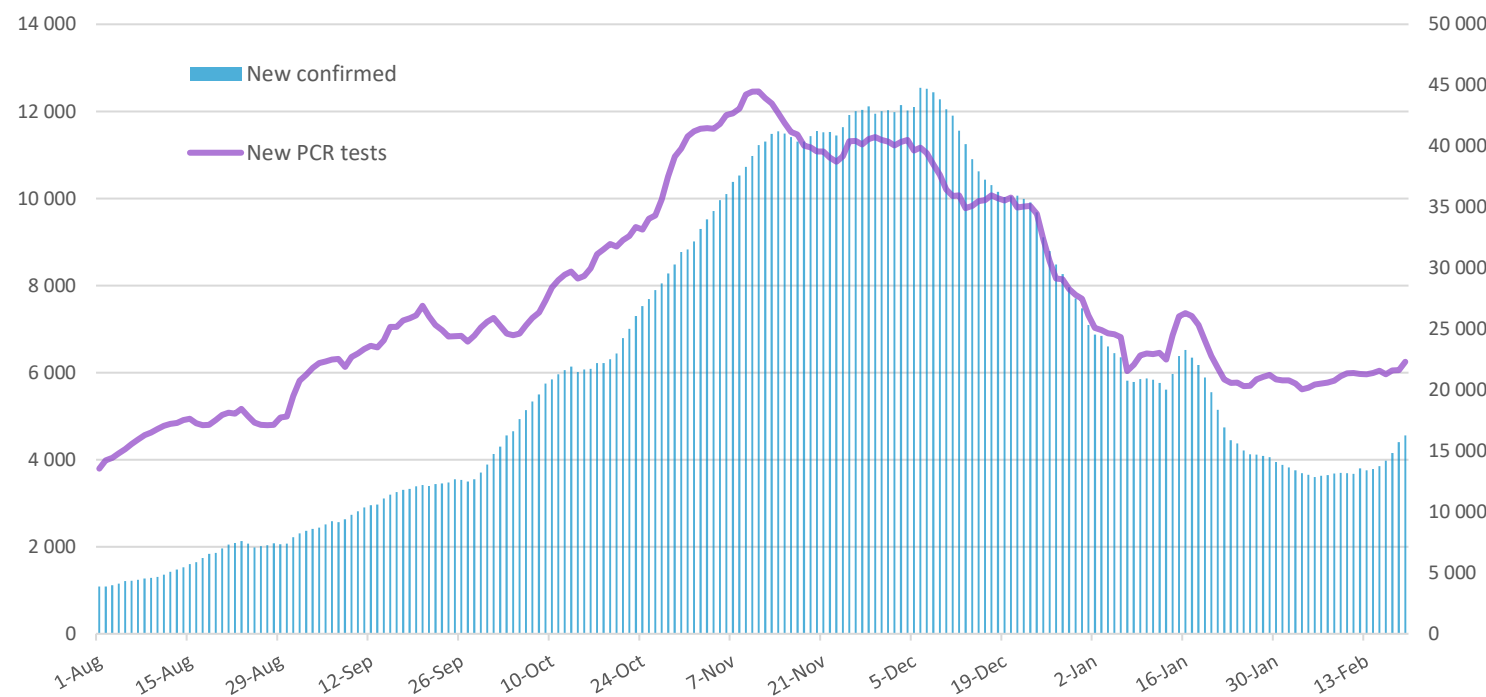
Comparison of number of daily confirmed cases and daily PCR tests



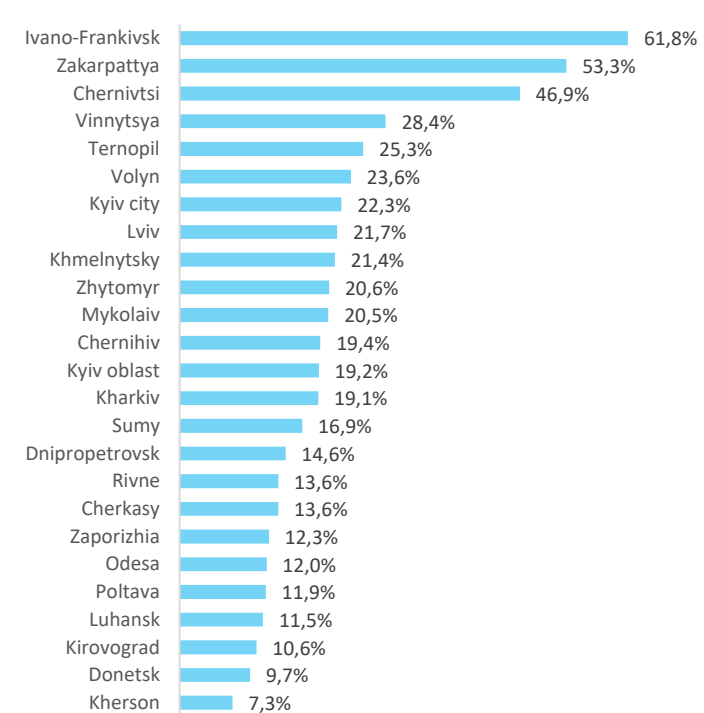
Number of COVID beds in hospitals

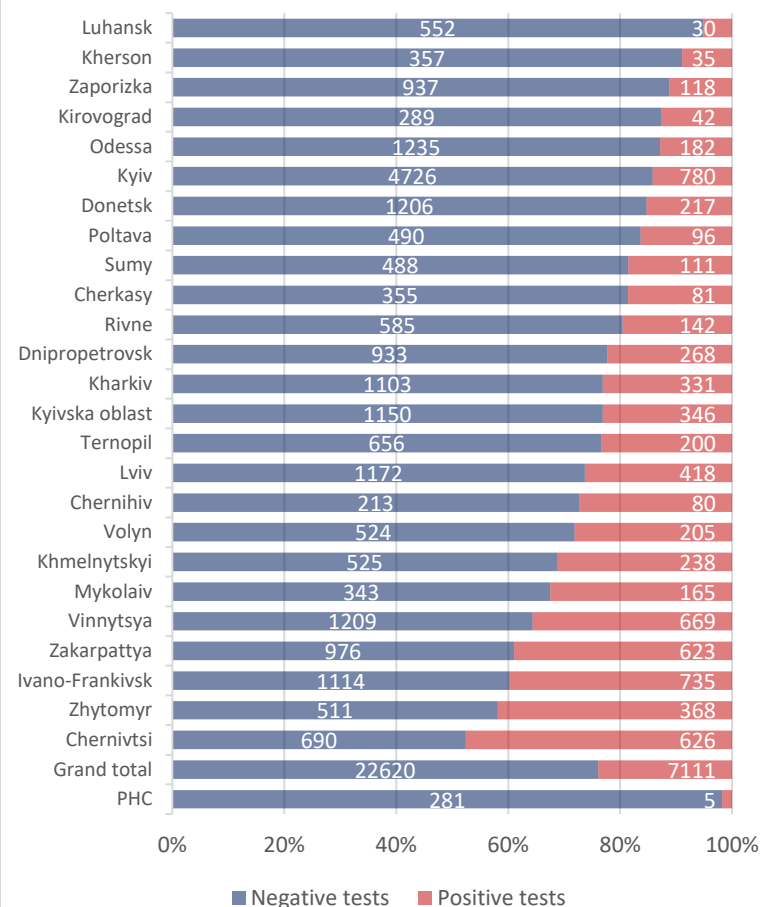

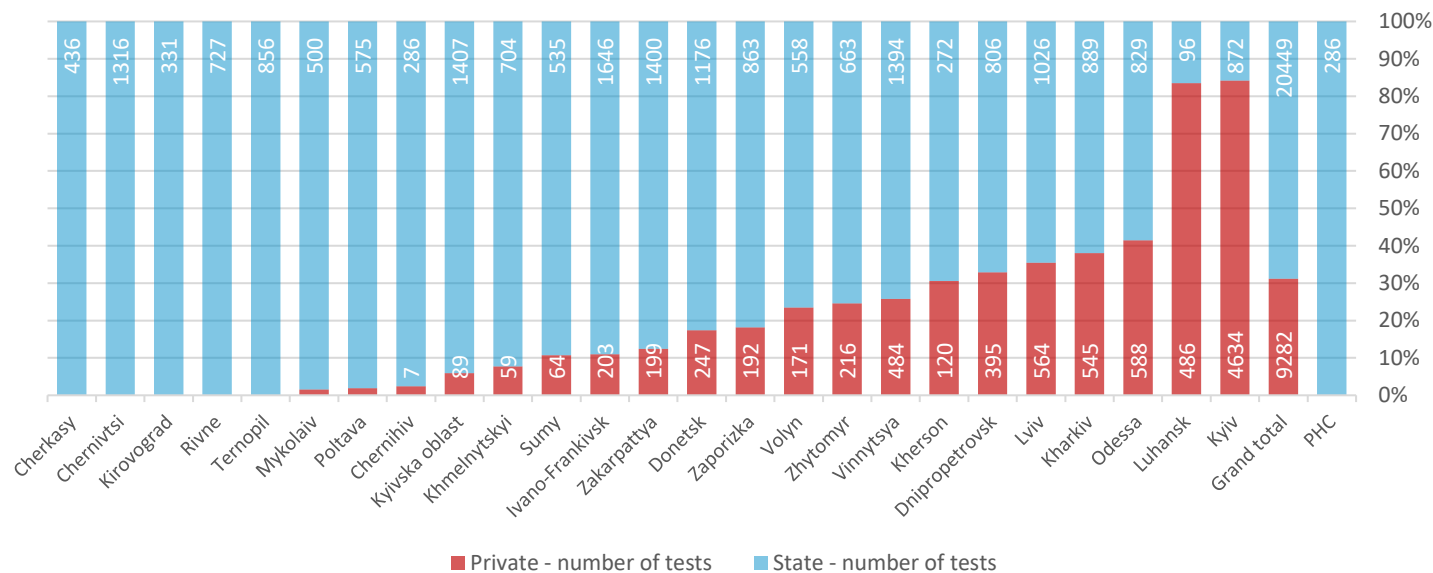

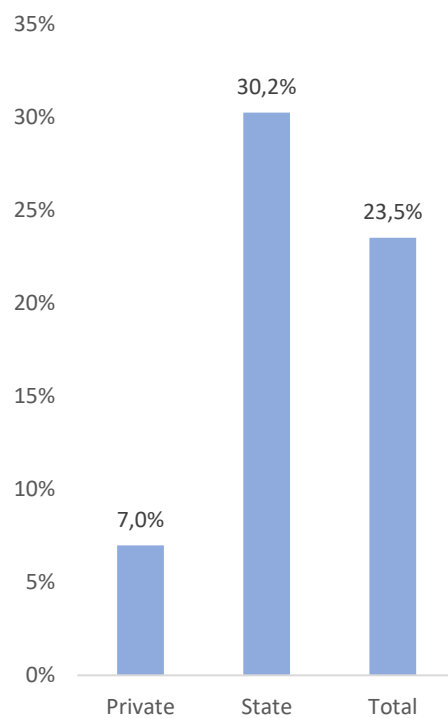
Number of positive* and negative results



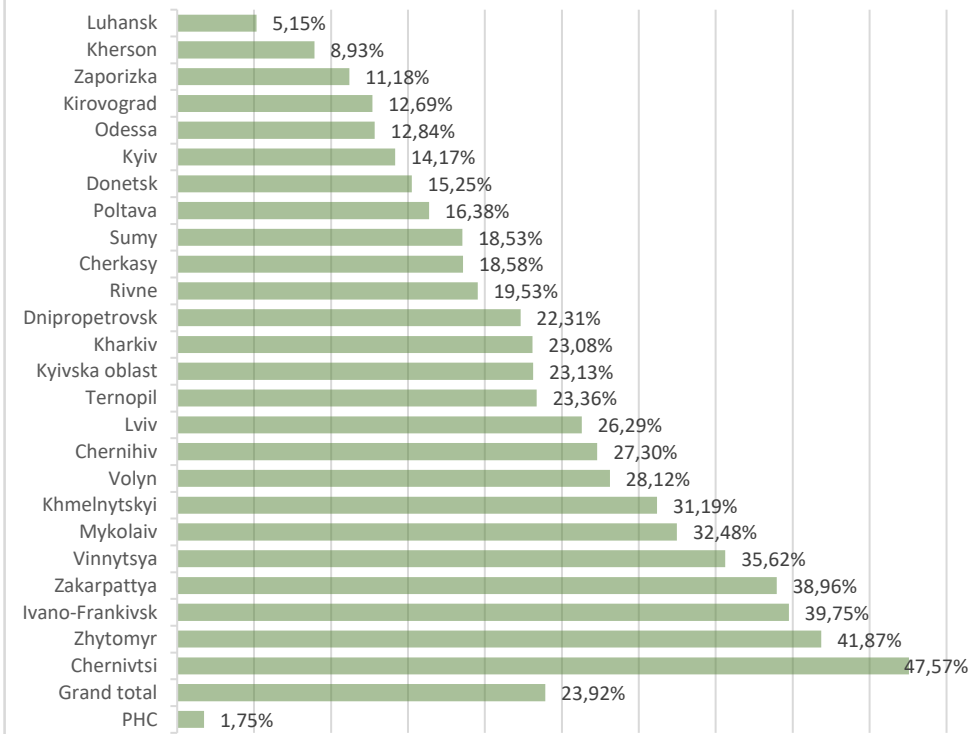
Share of tests done in private and state labs



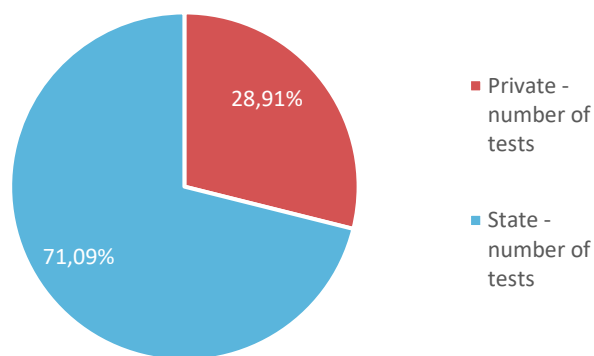
Positivity rate in private and state labs



Percent of positive result

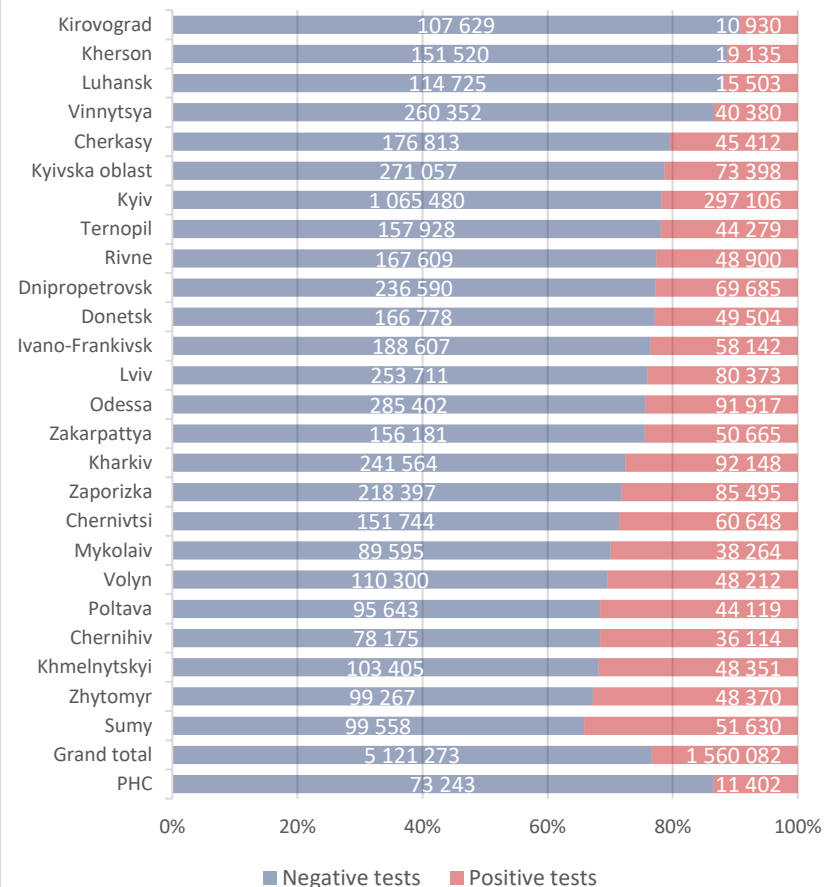

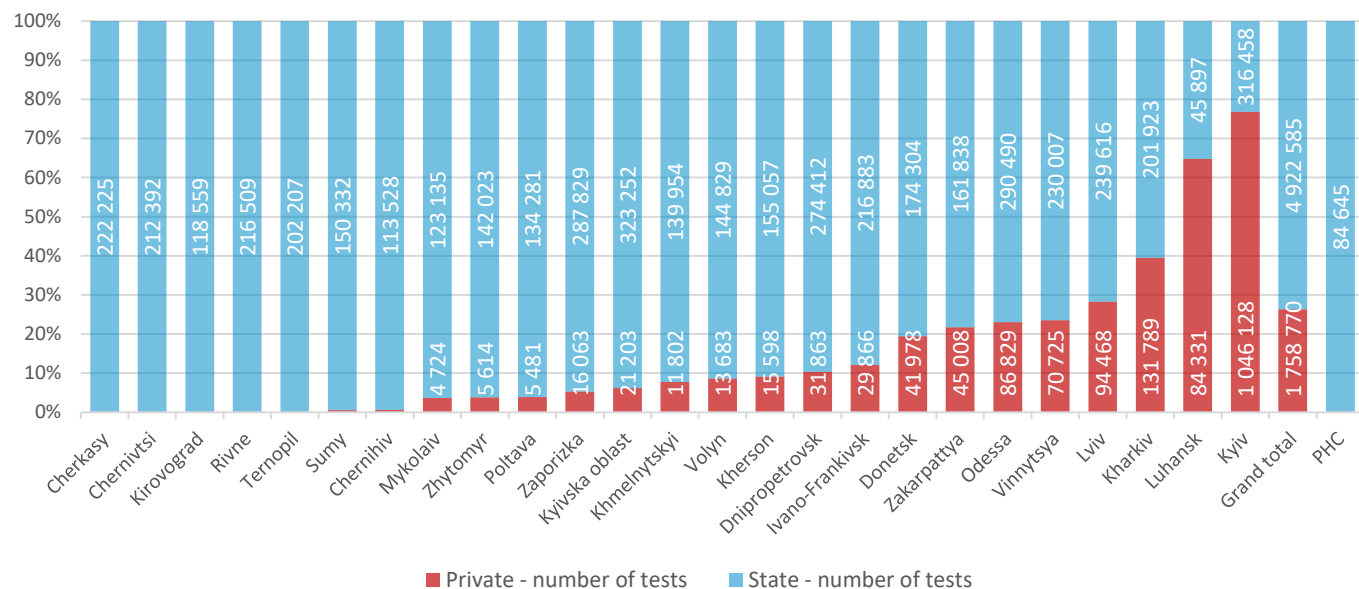


Cumulative information about laboratories and PCR testing in regions (as of February 20; 09:00)

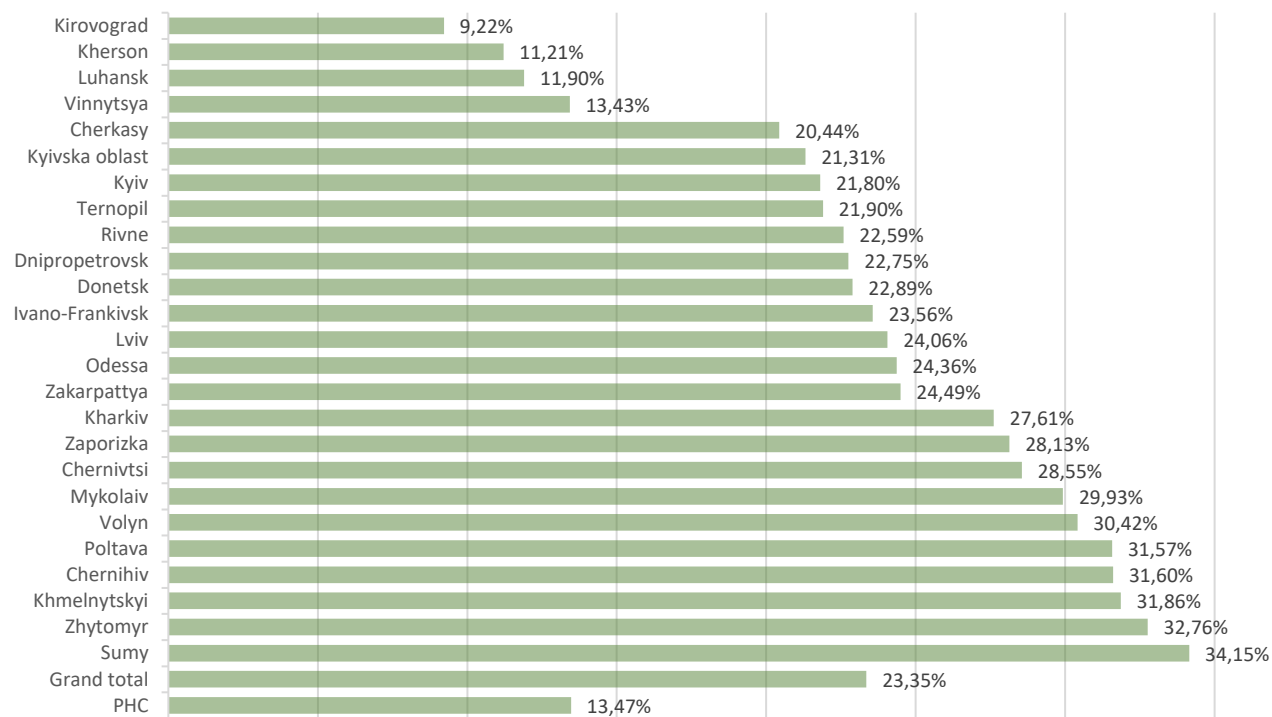

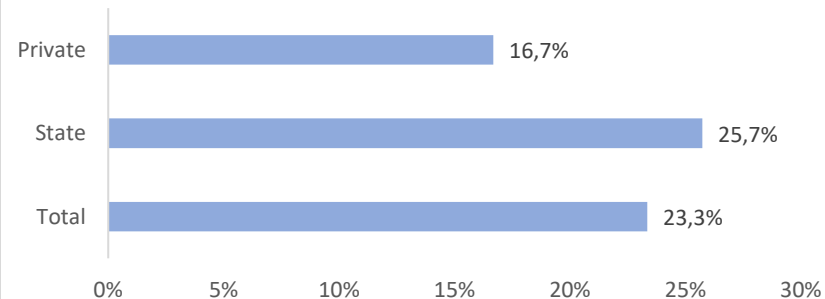
Share of tests done in private and state labs



Percent of positive result

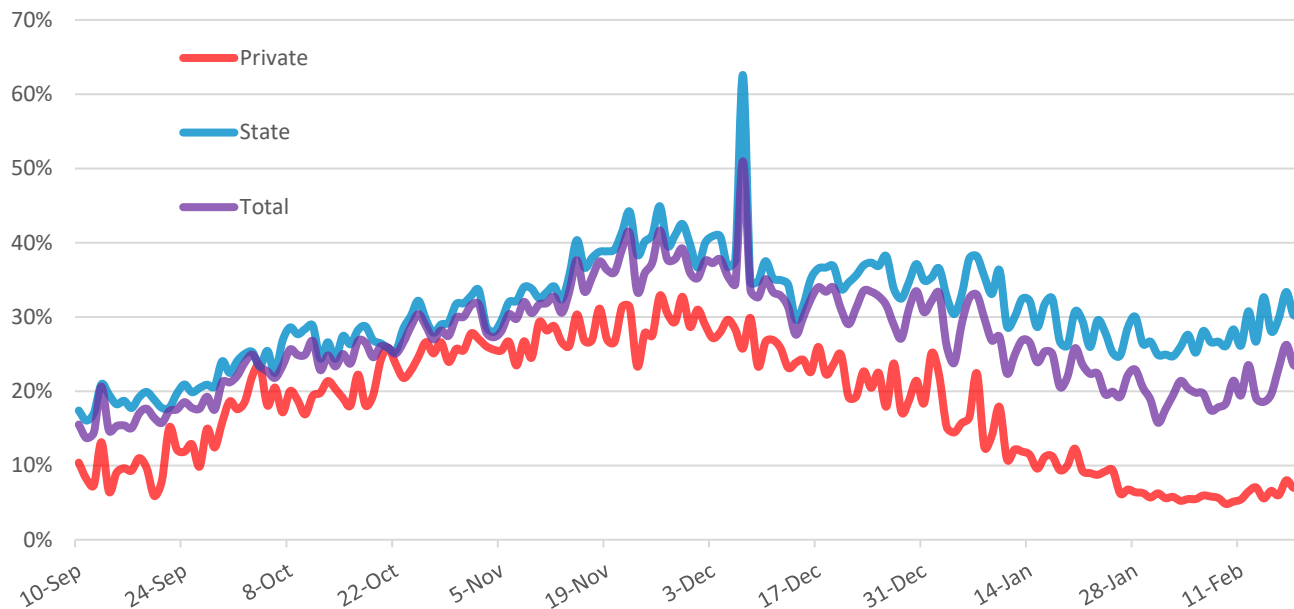

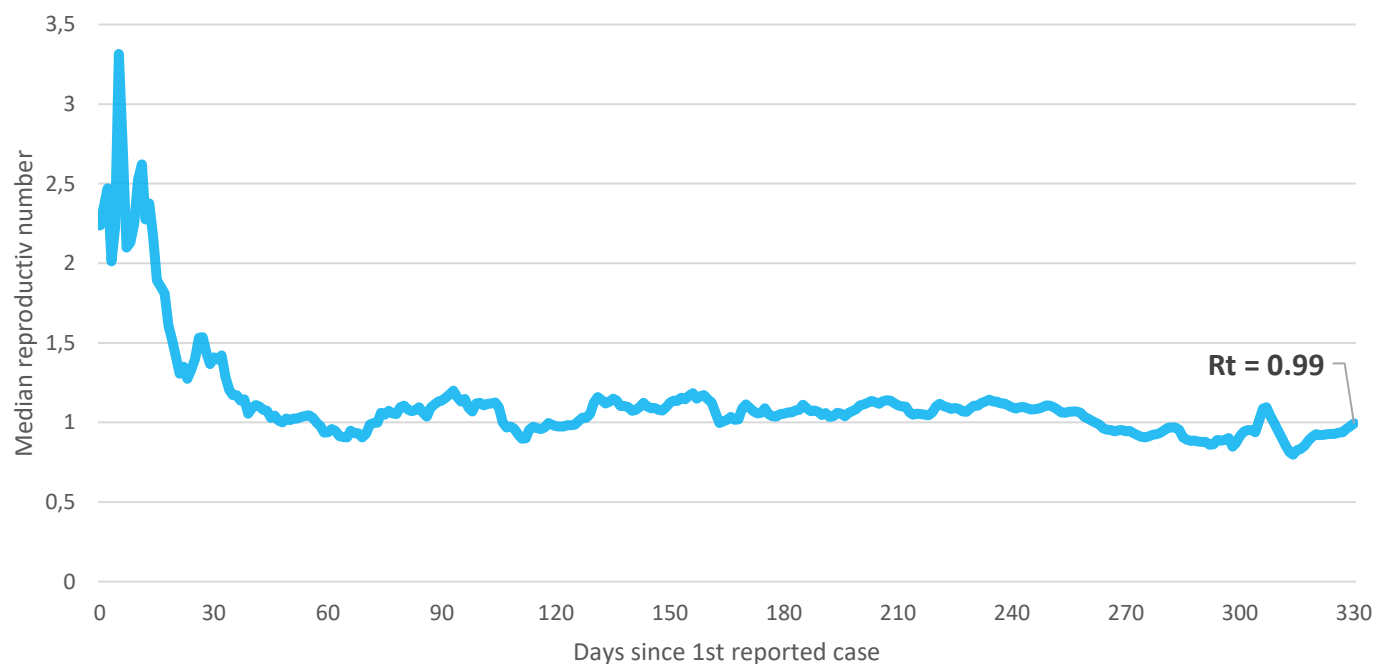
Changes in trend of test positivity



Latest measures of the government

- [The government has introduced adaptive quarantine in Ukraine since February 24](#). There will be four levels of epidemic danger, according to which certain restrictive measures will be established.
- The Ministry of Health of Ukraine together with partners launched a separate information portal on vaccination against COVID-19 - vaccination.covid19.gov.ua.
- [Pfizer has applied for registration of COVID-19 vaccine](#).
- [Practical training of mobile crews for immunization by Pfizer/BioNTech and AstraZeneca vaccines](#) from COVID-19 has started in Ukraine.
