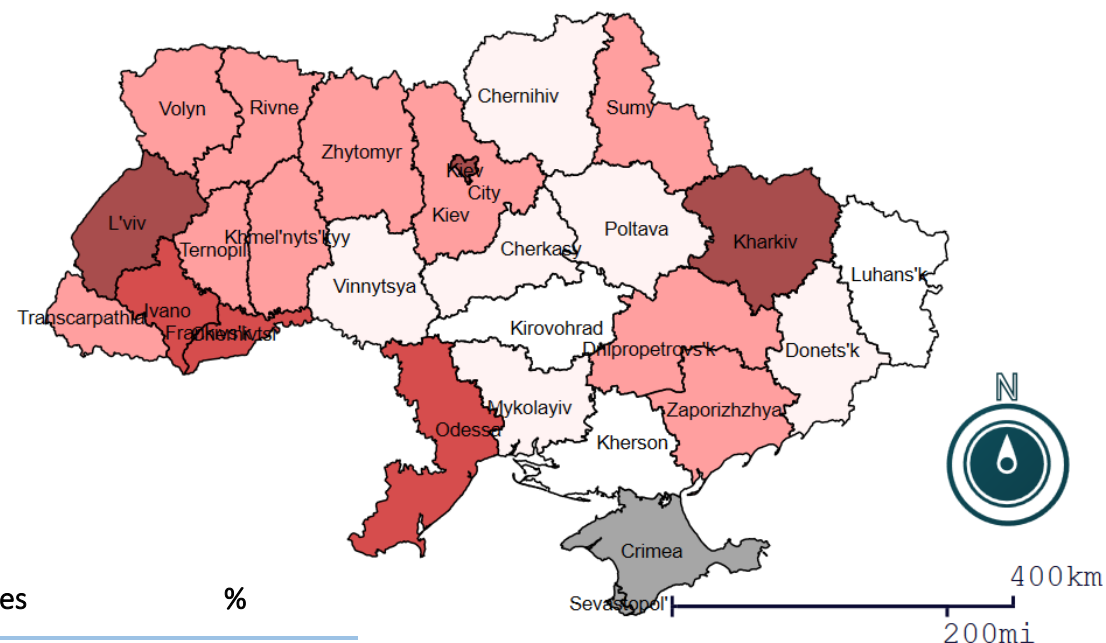
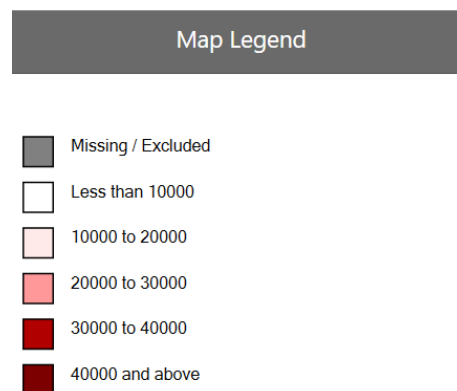

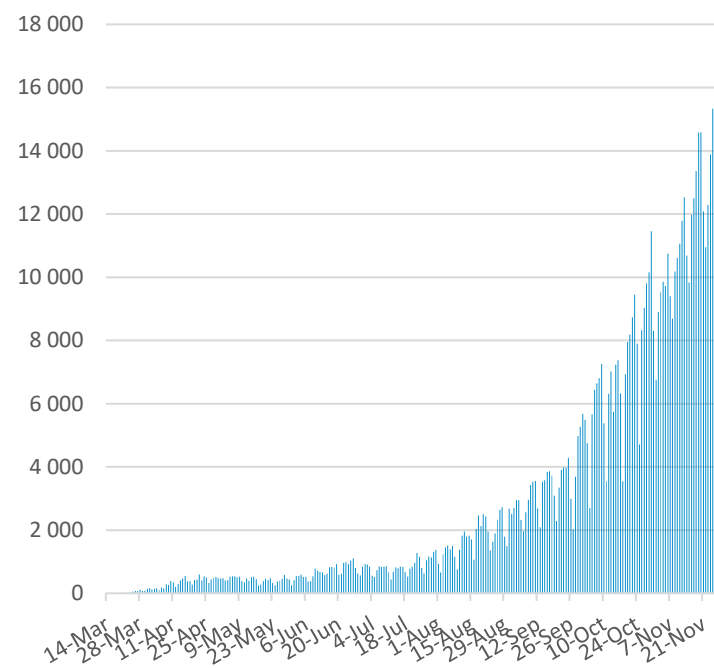
Number of confirmed cases in regions



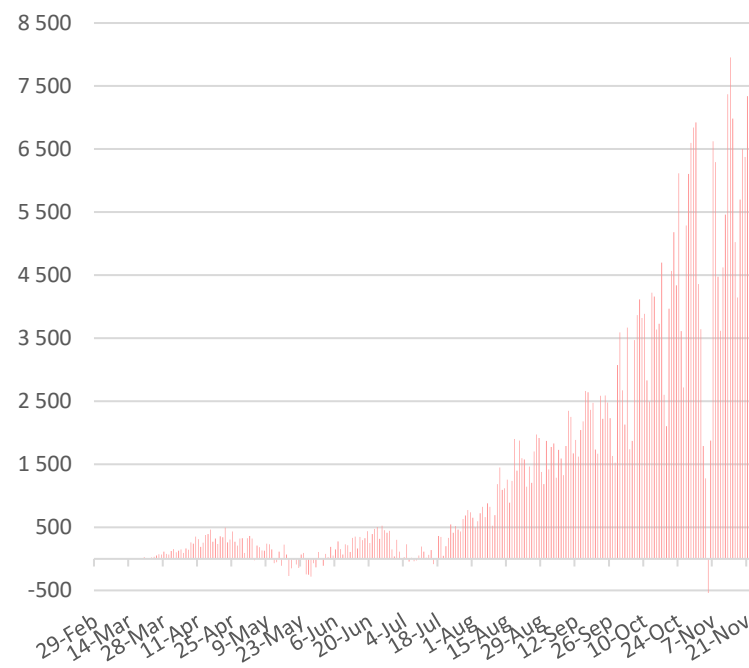

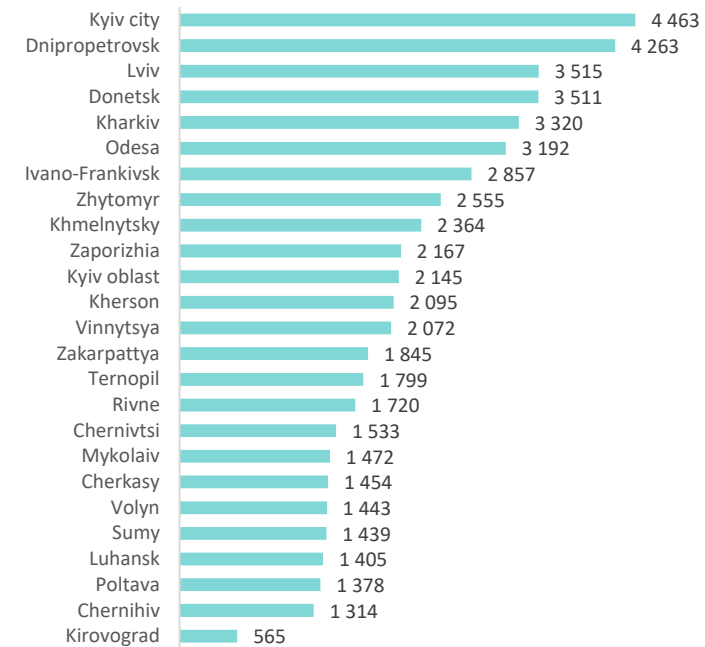
Confirmed cases by date of reporting



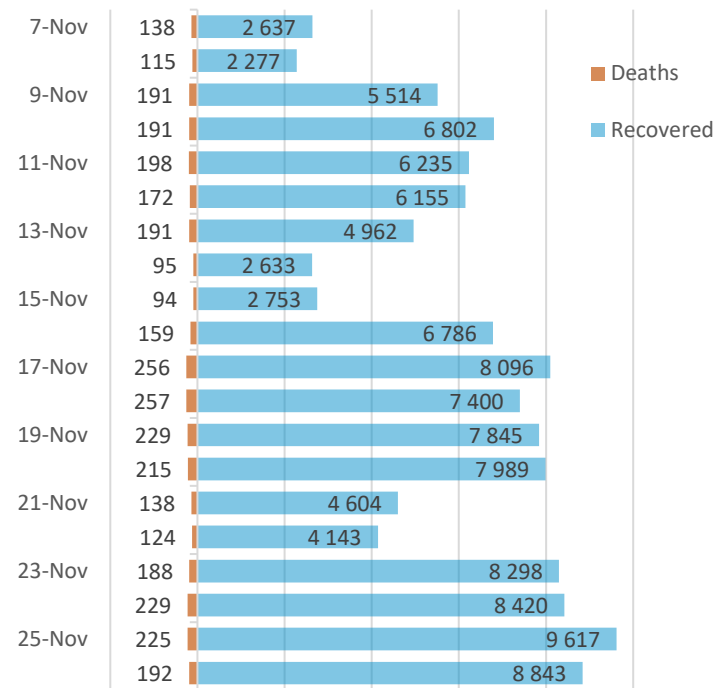
Active cases per day



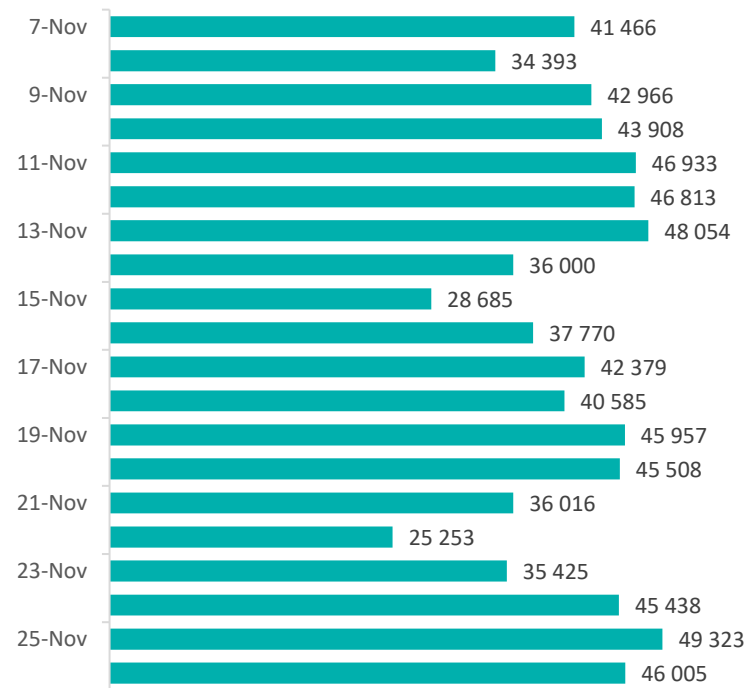
Number of beds in first-wave hospitals



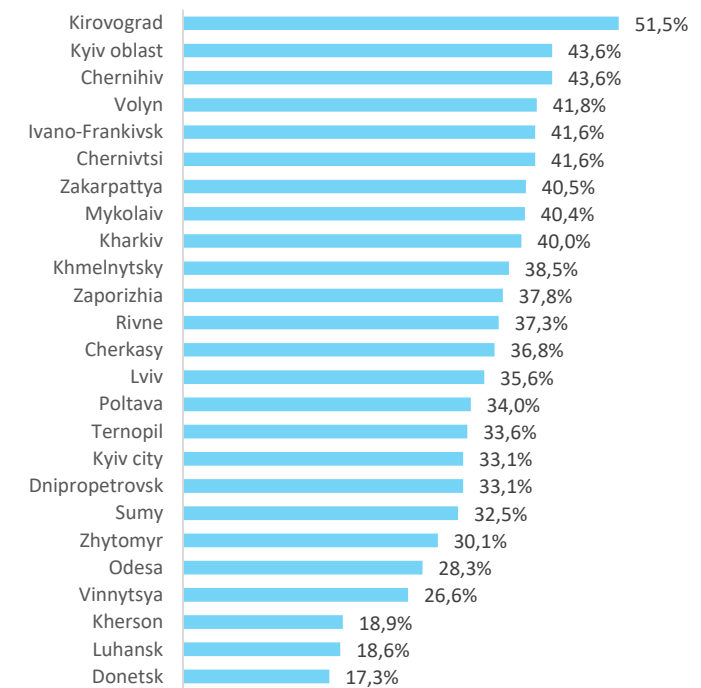
Lethal and recovered cases

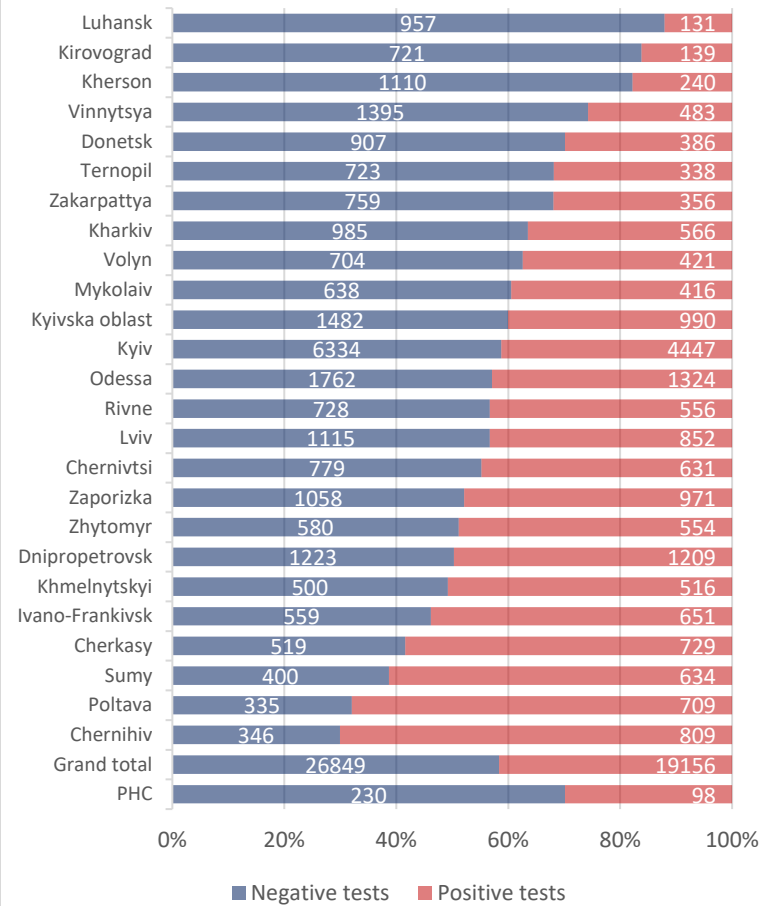

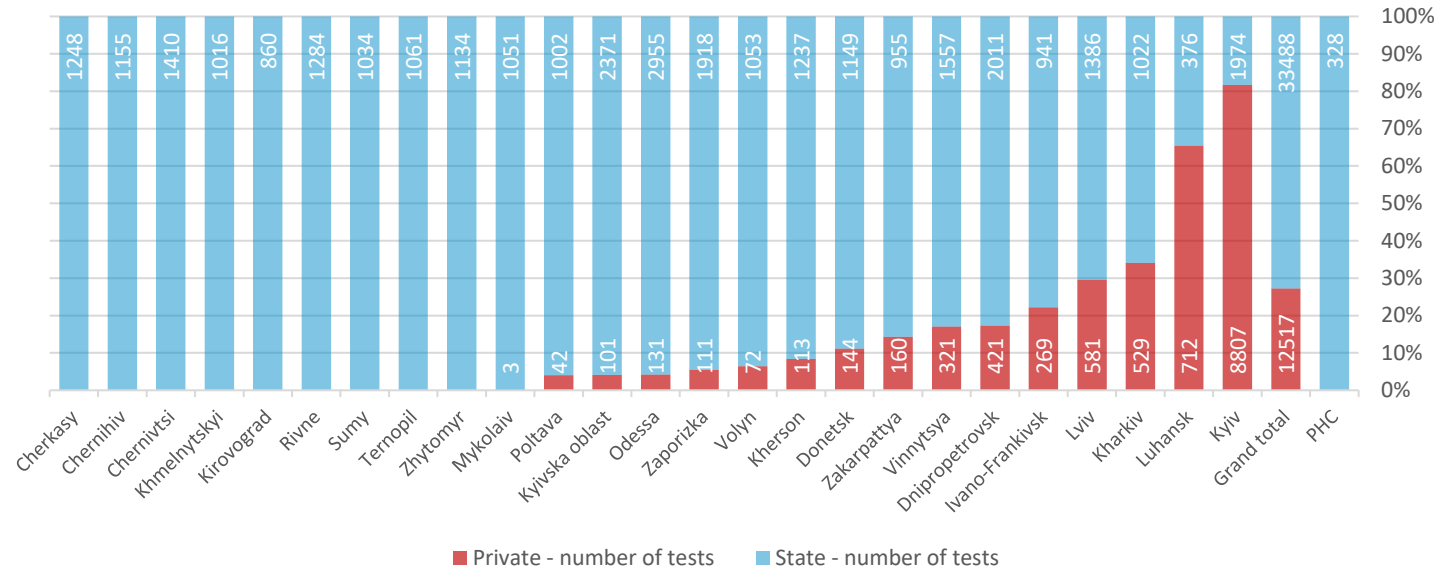

Daily information about laboratories and PCR testing in regions (as of November 27, 09:00)

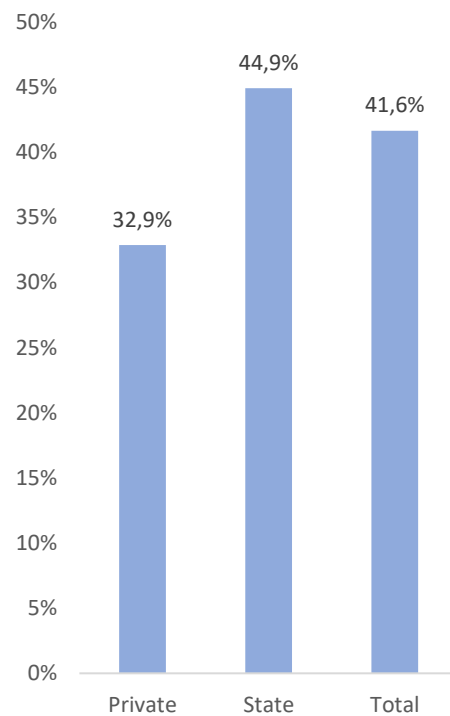
Number of positive* and negative results



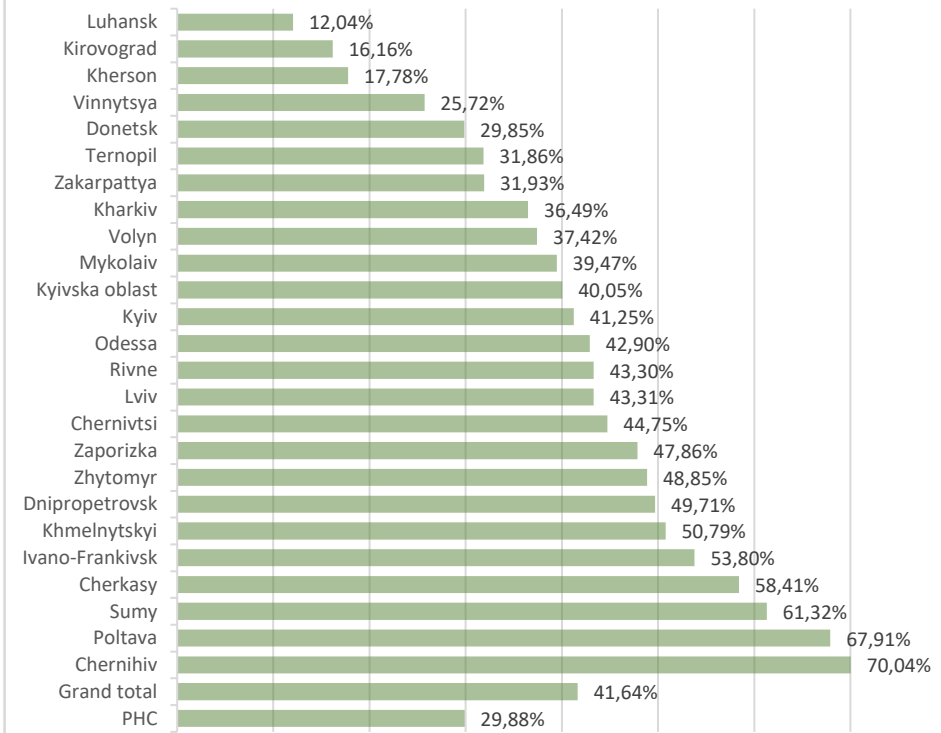
Share of tests done in private and state labs



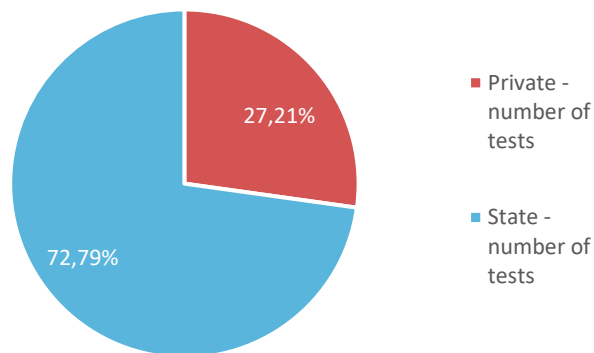
Positivity rate in private and state labs



Percent of positive result

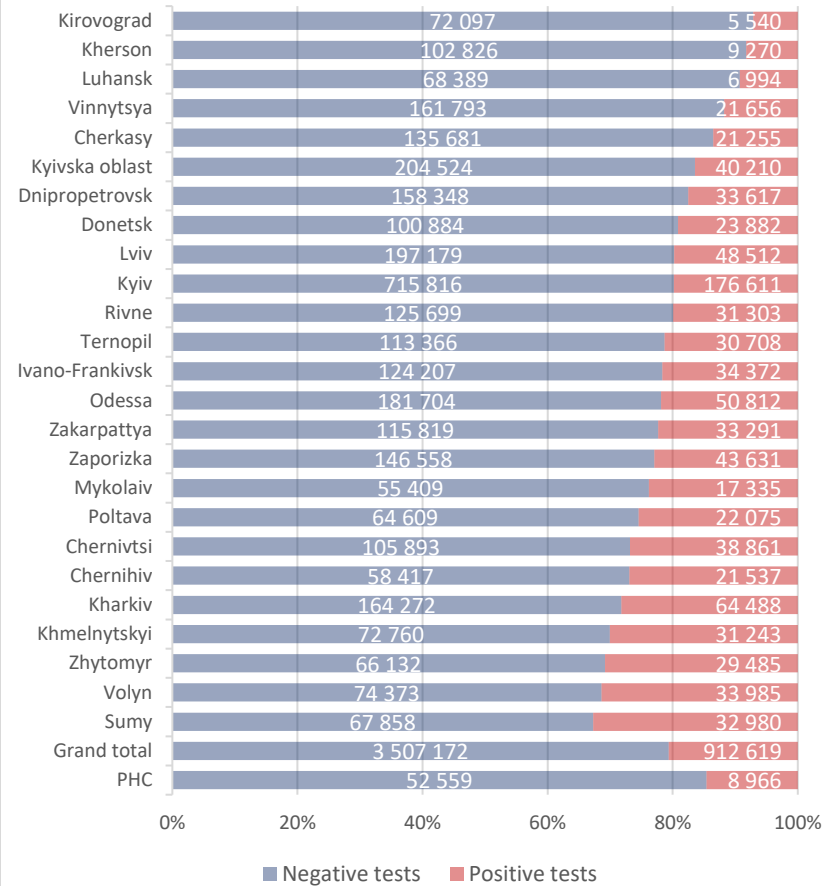

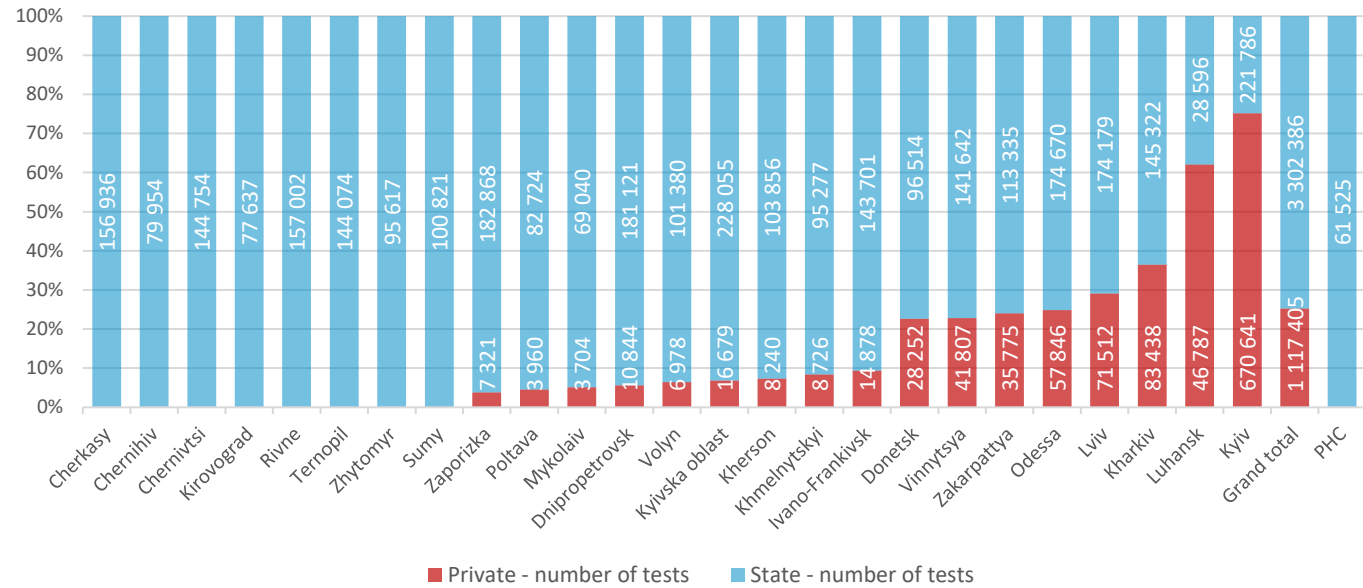

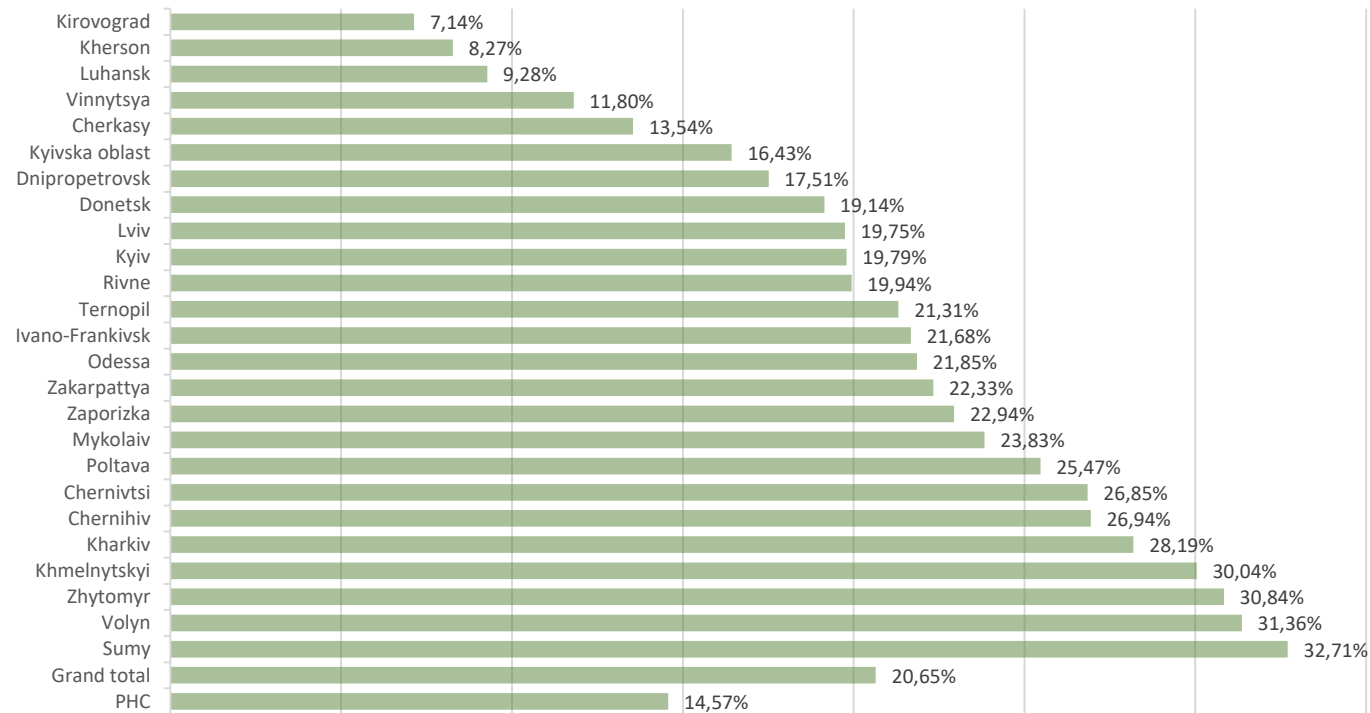

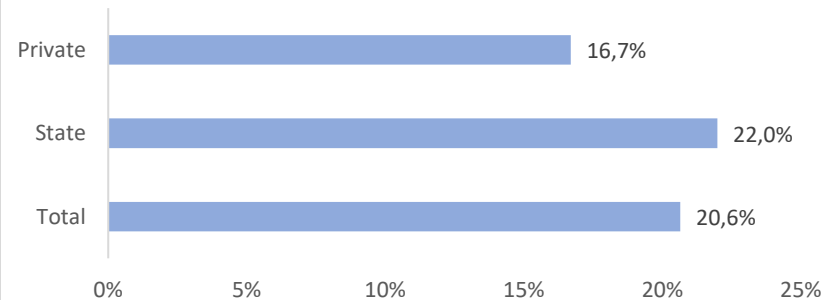
Share of tests done in private and state labs



Percent of positive result



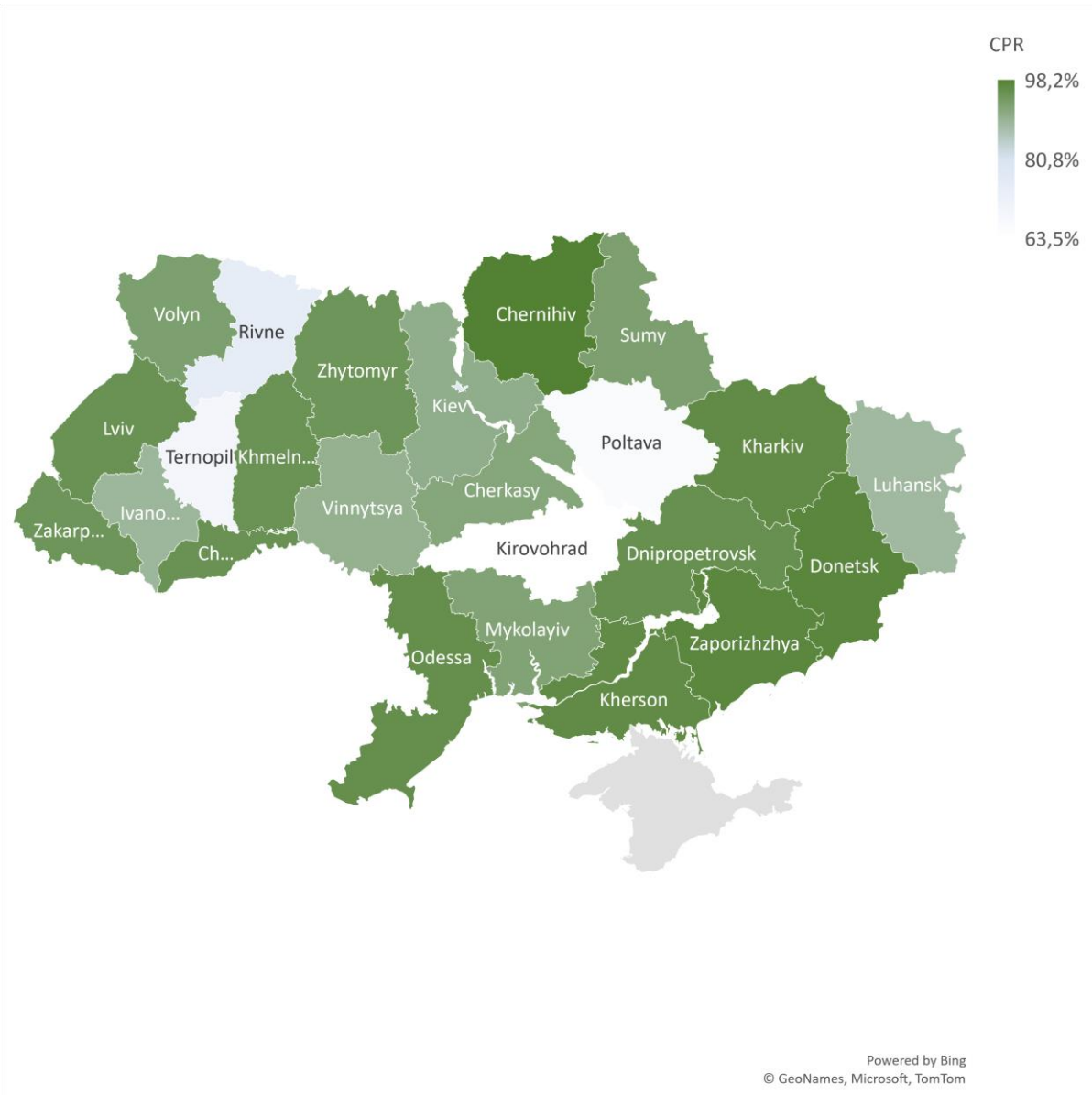

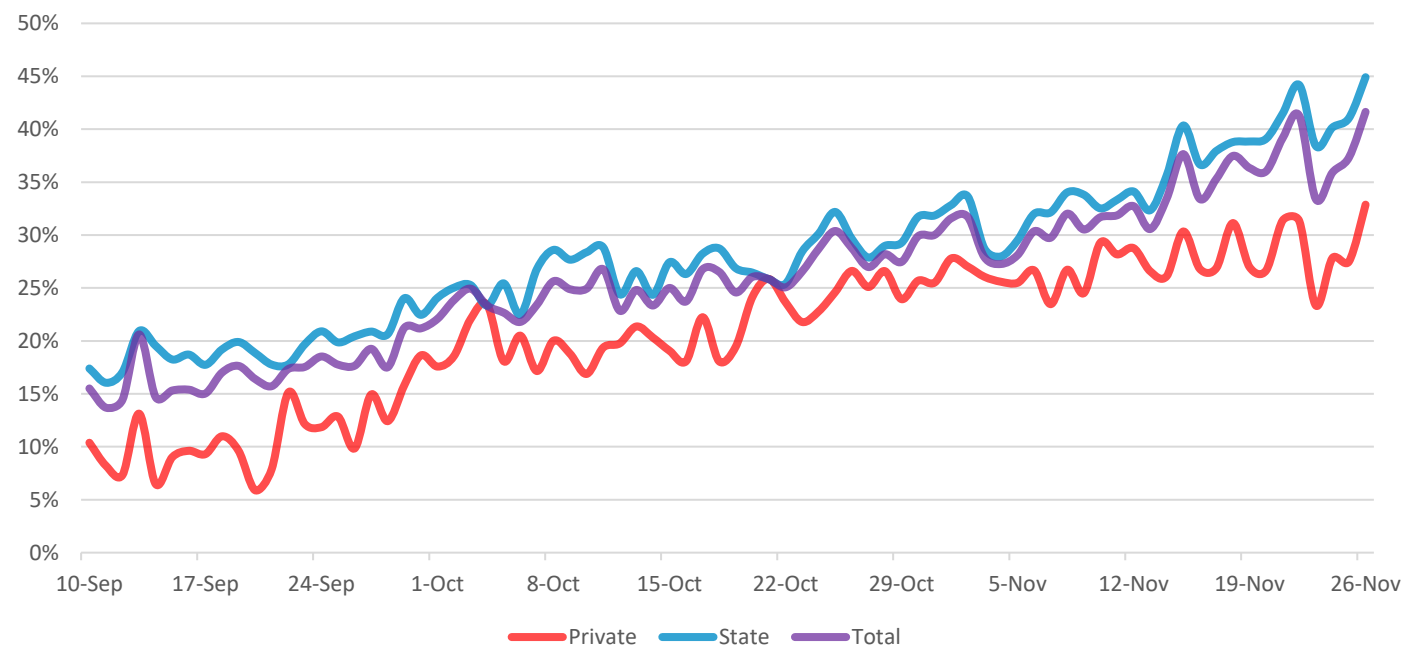

Case positivity rate in regions (% of confirmed cases out of suspected)

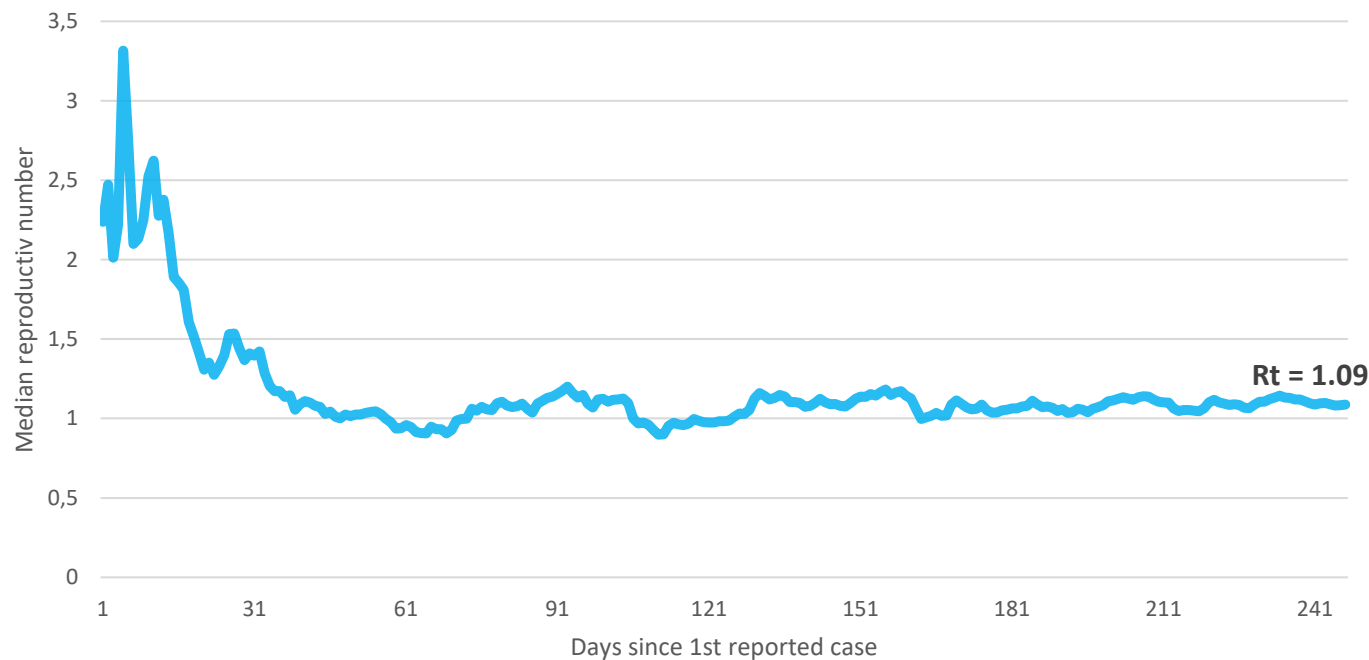

Latest measures of the government

- [Government has changed quarantine restrictions](#) with actual shifting from “adaptive quarantine” and dividing country into 4 zones of epidemic danger. Restrictions previously effective for “orange” zone are now de-facto applied for the whole country.
- [The government has additionally allocated UAH 895.578 million](#) to provide oxygen to beds in medical institutions.
- [UAH 118.5 million was allocated for the deployment of temporary hospitals.](#)
- [Amendments to the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine](#), which introduce "Priority Years" for the elderly, come into force and are aimed at reducing the level of infection of at-risk groups.
- [If the Parliament adopts the Law "On the State Budget of Ukraine for 2021"](#), considering the proposed by the Ministry of Health funding of 296.6 billion UAH, the salary of doctors will be at least 22-25 thousand UAH.
- Prime Minister discussed with the EIB Vice-[President the purchase of a vaccine against COVID-19 by Ukraine](#).
- [Ukraine will purchase 6 million COVID express test kits](#), says PM.
