# Today's covid-19 statements - download the files here

All weekdays at 14 we publish files with today's latest covid-19 statements.

The files deal with all covid-19 statements - both data that is presented daily on SSI's covid-19 dashboard and monitoring data.

## Change - from March 10, 2021

Note from Wednesday, March 10, 2021, all inventories include both data from public and private test providers and thus both PCR and antigen tests. In addition to data from TestCenter Denmark and the country's Clinical Microbiology Departments, public data now also includes test efforts in schools. Data from the private test providers cover both publicly funded and non-publicly funded tests. It should be noted that more private test providers are being connected to the inventory on an ongoing basis as more people start reporting to SSI.

Covid-19 cases are defined as a person with a positive test result, whether from PCR or antigen tests. A "data jump" can be expected both in the number of tests and in the number of cases from 9 March to 10 March 2021, as explained by the above.

If you subtract private antigen statements from today's figures (the last 24 hours), the change from yesterday to today is 666 confirmed cases (the total number is 216,457 confirmed cases).

If you deduct additional private PCR statements from today's figures (the last 24 hours), the change from yesterday to today is 602 confirmed cases (the total number is 216,393 confirmed cases).

The number of 602 confirmed cases may be slightly underestimated, as there may be citizens who have been tested both privately and publicly with PCR.
