Development of data collection systems during the pandemic

In Italy, two sources provide information on COVID-19 deaths: the Civil Protection Department and the National Institute of Health. The Civil Protection Department publishes a daily update of the number of deaths at 17:00, but does not provide age and sex breakdowns for these deaths. The ISS has been publishing reports since March 2020. From 22 July 2020 onwards, these reports were weekly. From 5 January 2021, Excel files were also available, published every day until 15 April 2022, and only from Monday to Friday since.

The ISS receives and verifies all data from each regional health authority, including case sheets for hospitalized patients.

All COVID-19 cases are diagnosed by regional reference laboratories, as indicated by Ministry of Health circular no. 0005443 of 22 February 2020. See the "Methodological Note" available in the documentation [in Italian]

New source file

Since 5 January 2021, the ISS publishes on its dashboard (available here: <u>https://www.epicentro.iss.it/coronavirus/sars-cov-2-dashboard</u>), an excel file containing information on the daily number of deaths by date of occurrence on the one hand, and on the distribution by age and sex of the deaths that occurred until the day of publication on the other hand.

These data are reproduced in the "ISS_Age&Sex_Daily" and "ISS_by_occurrence_date" tabs. When the total number of deaths is less than 5 for a given category (date or age-gender crossover), the exact number is not specified (replaced by '<5'). We replace "<5" with "0" in order to calculate the cumulative number of deaths. Therefore, totals should be taken with caution. Deaths that are not disclosed in the daily publication for confidentiality reasons, are revealed in the weekly report. However, for these deaths only the sex is known.

The time series coming from this data source and published in the excel sheet "ISS_by_occurrence_date", includes death counts occurred since the beginning of the pandemic and may account for retrospective corrections.
