



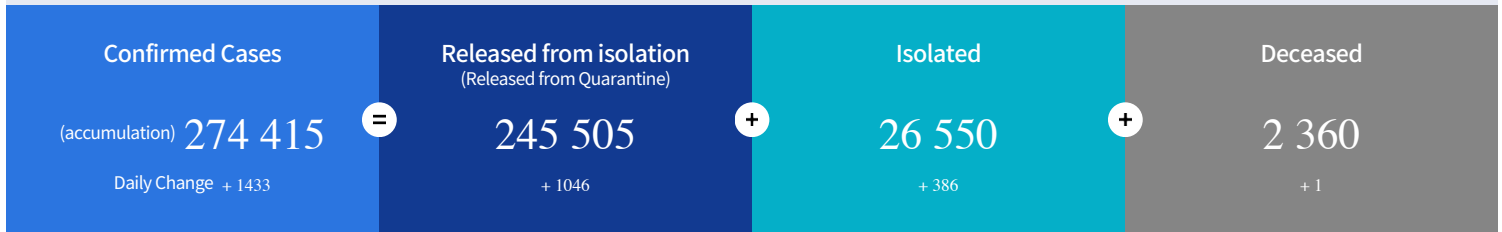

**Social distancing extended for 4 weeks (Sept. 6. ~ Oct. 3.)**  
**Level 4 for greater Seoul area, level 3 for non-greater Seoul areas**  
**Private gathering exception for fully vaccinated people expanded** \* Up to 6 people for level 4, 8 people for level 3  
※ [Level 4] For people who are not vaccinated or have received the first shot, private gatherings of up to 4 people before 6 p.m. and 2 people after 6 p.m. are allowed as they were previously.



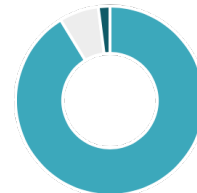
## Cases in Korea (as of 12am on September 13, 2021, data aggregated from January 3)

In Progress 925739/6.7 %

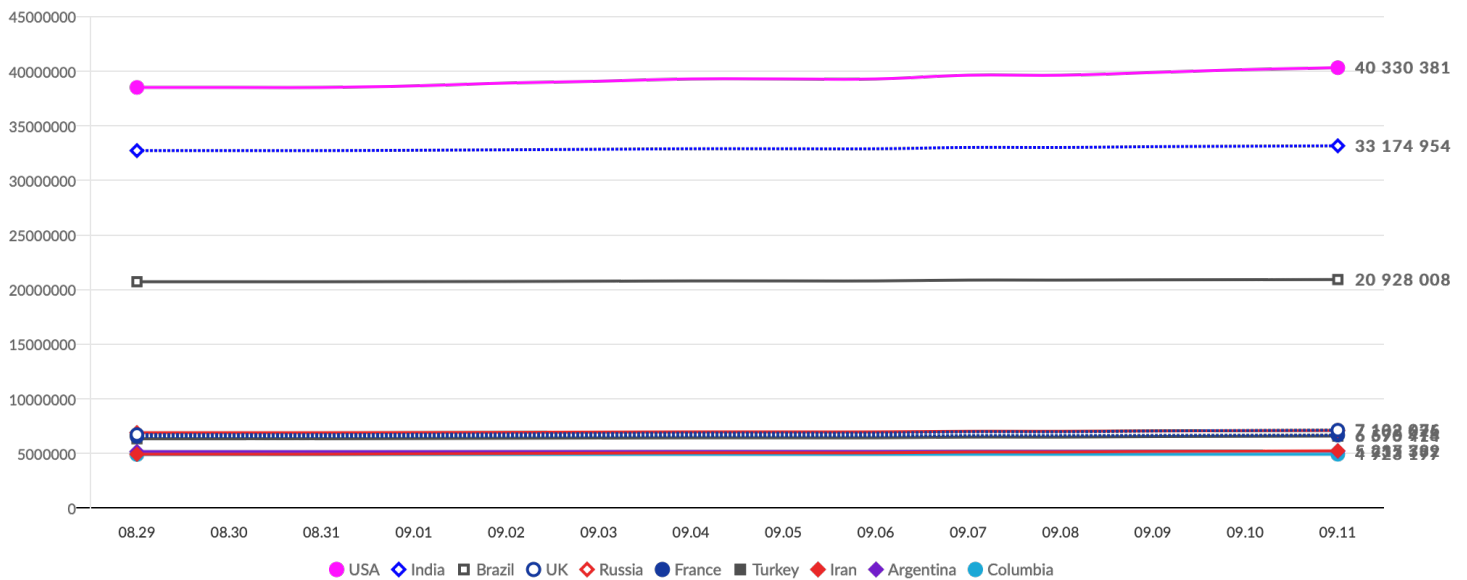
