Social Distancing

Social distancing adjusted for 2 weeks (10/18 (Mon.)–10/31 (Sun.)).

While level 4 is maintained in the greater Seoul area and level 3 is maintained in other areas, restrictions on the number of people allowed for private gatherings are to be relaxed.*

* Up to 8 people possible in level 4 areas when including those who have completed vaccination; up to 10 people possible in level 3 areas when including those who have completed vaccination.

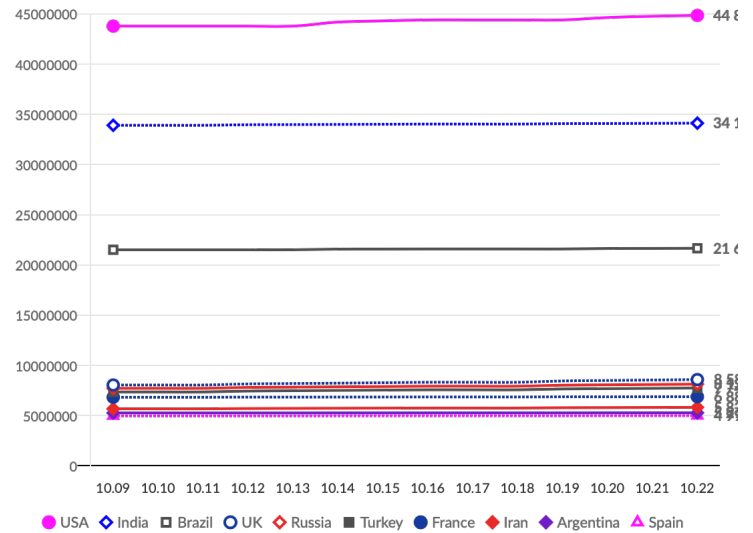
