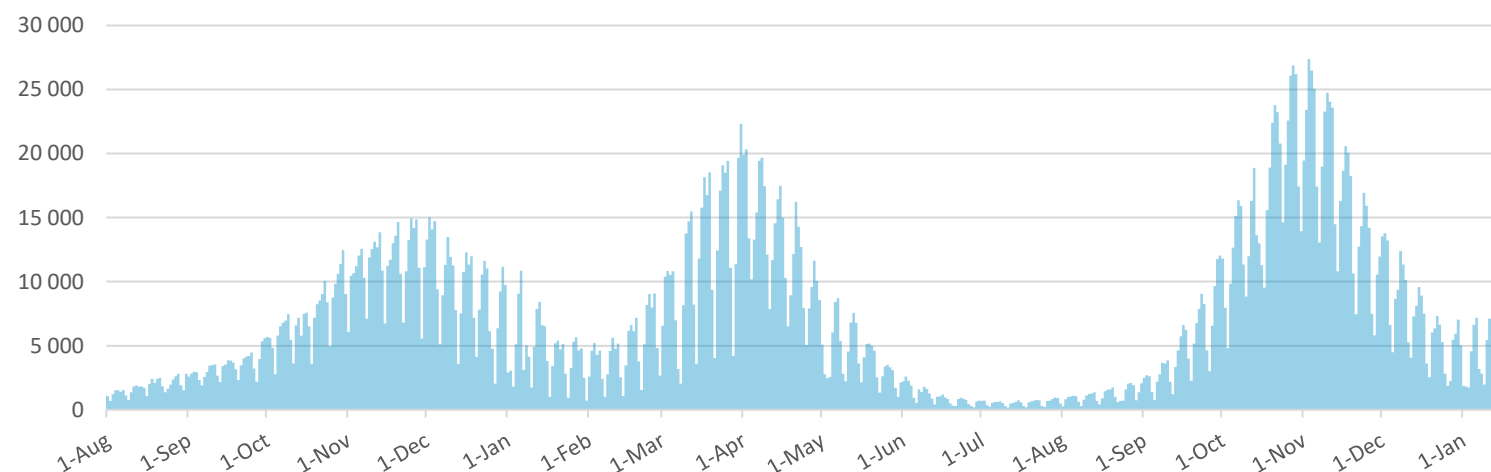

Confirmed cases by the date of reporting



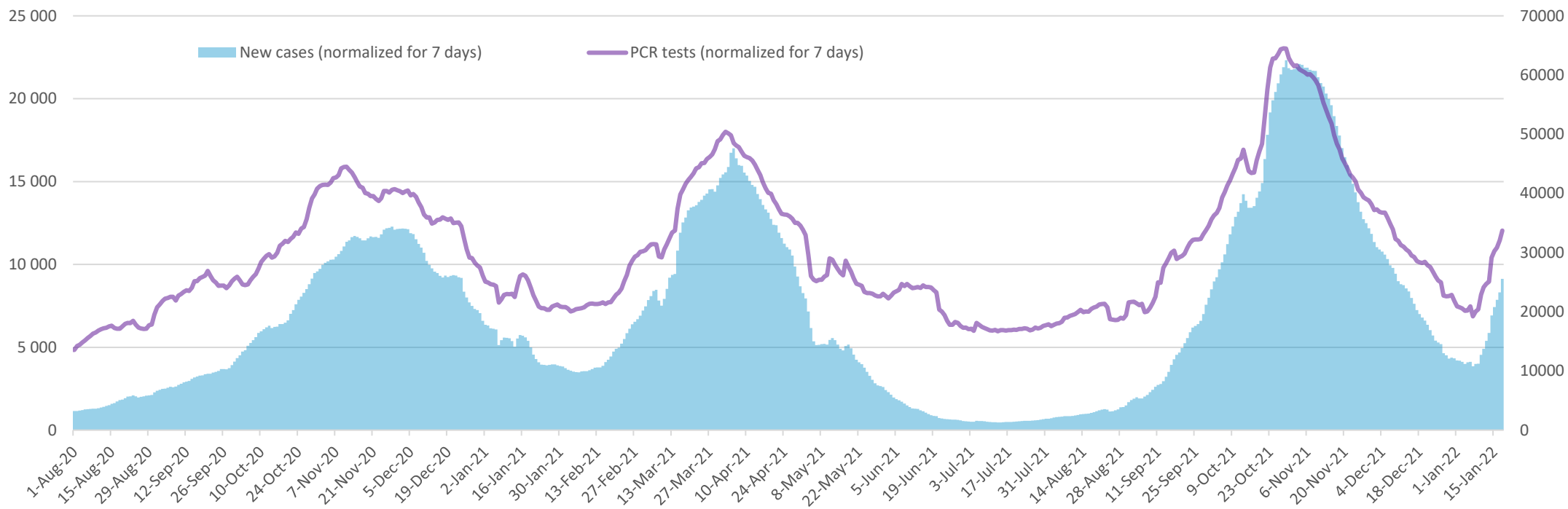

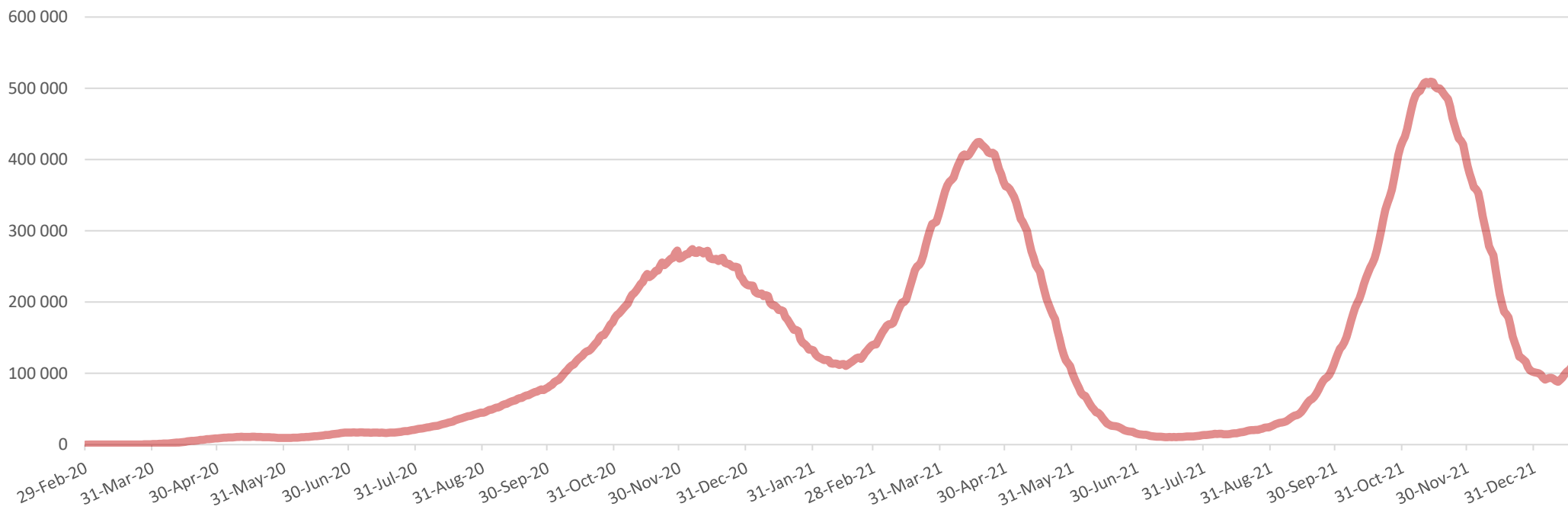

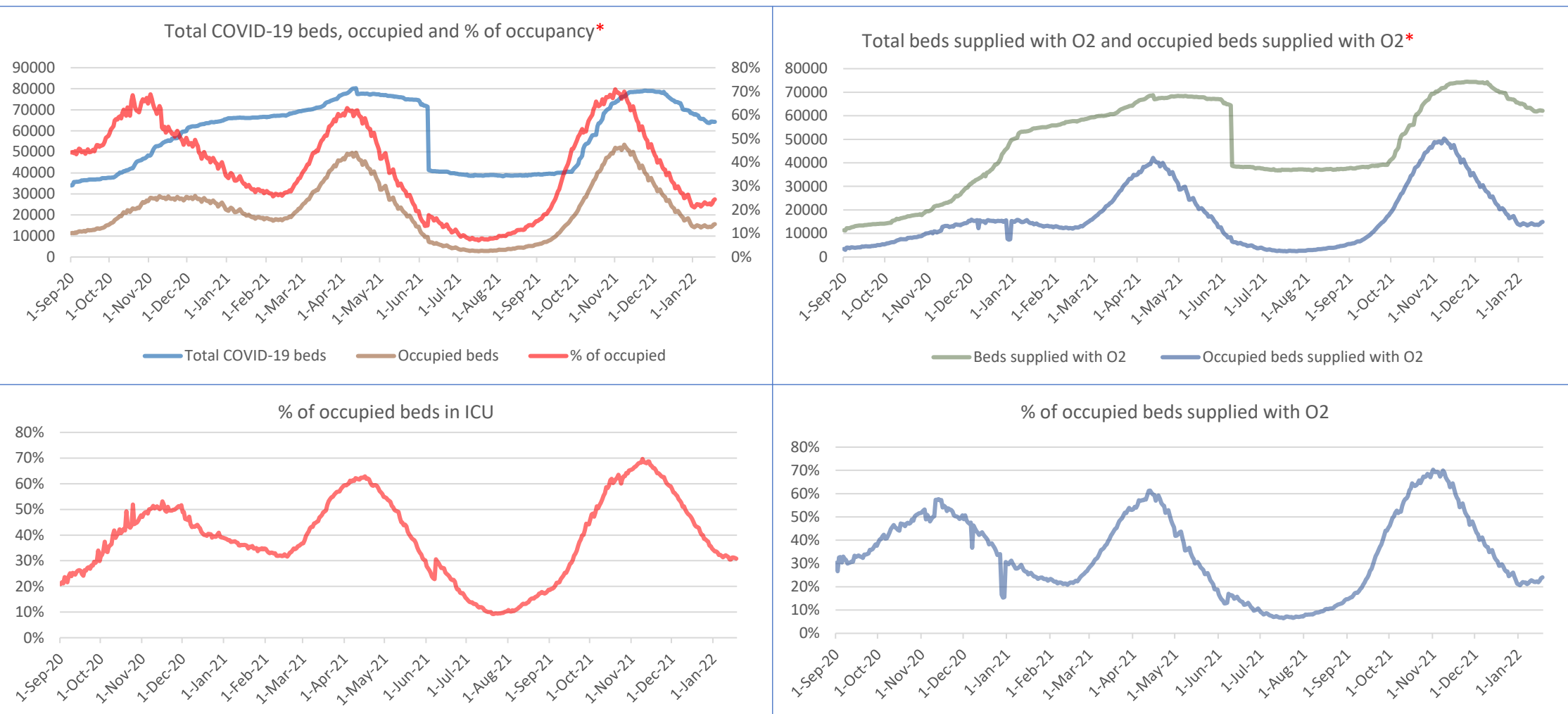
Comparison of number of daily confirmed cases and daily PCR tests (normalized for 7 days)

- Vinnytsya region – 38.9%

Share of beds occupied by suspected and confirmed cases in the same regions:

- Ivano-Frankivsk region – 50.5%
- Vinnytsya region – 40.3%

Share of beds occupied in ICU:

- Ivano-Frankivsk region – 42.6%
- Vinnytsya region – 48.6%

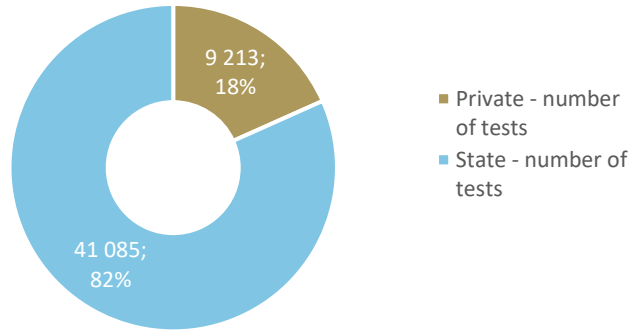

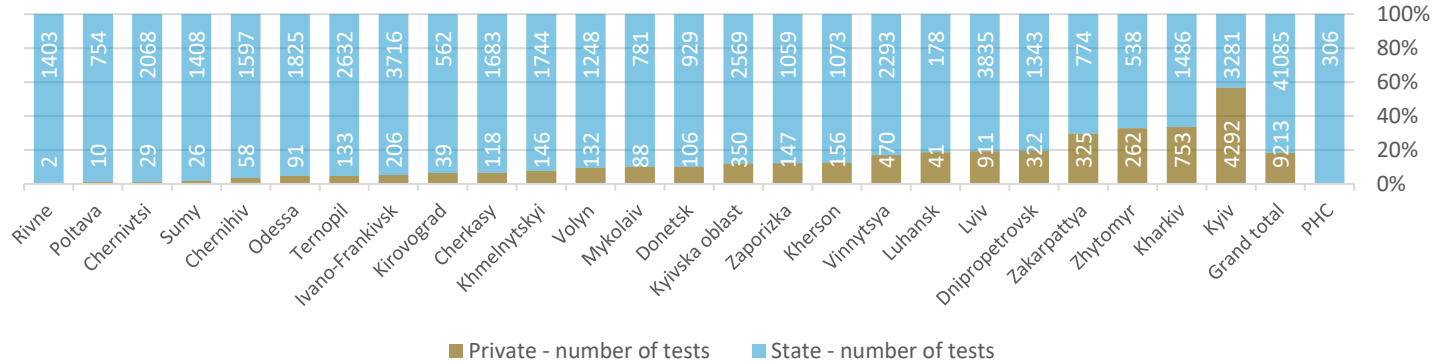

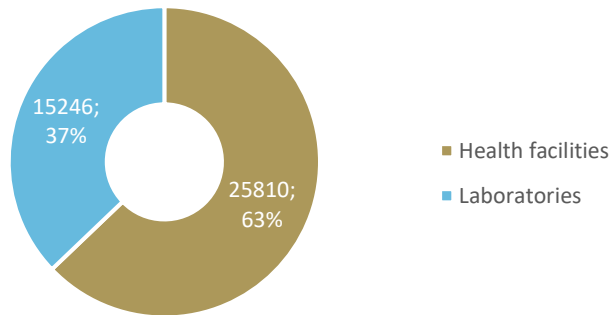
PCR tests done in private and state labs



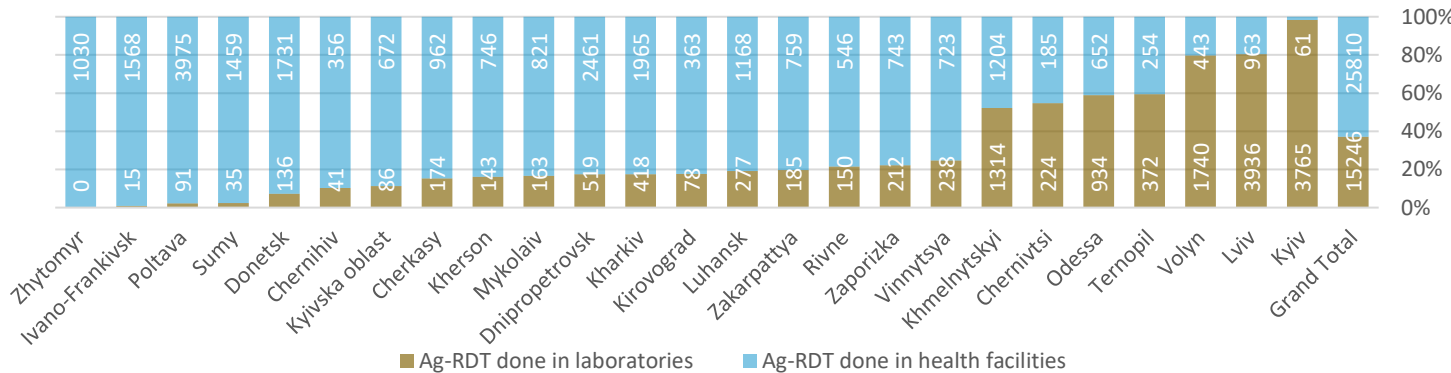
Share of PCR tests done in private and state labs



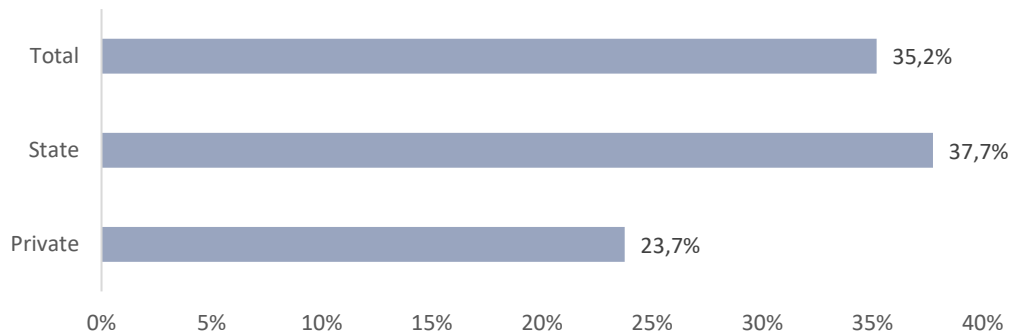
Ag-RDT done in laboratories and health facilities



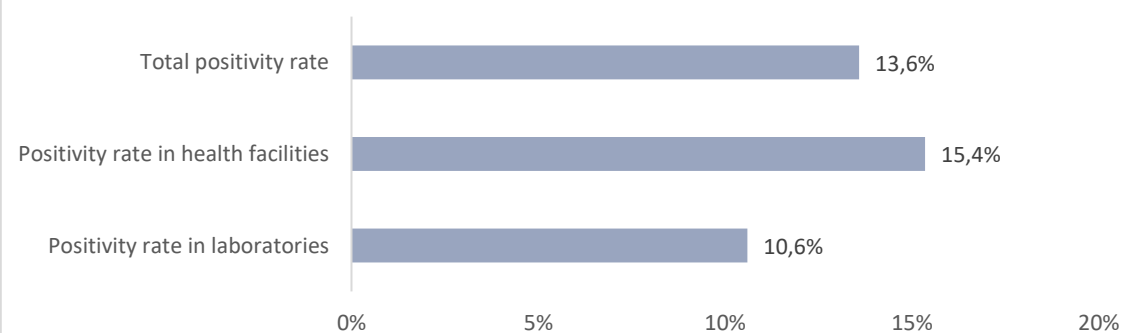
Share of Ag-RDT done in health facilities and laboratories

Daily positivity rate (Ag-RDT) in laboratories and health facilities

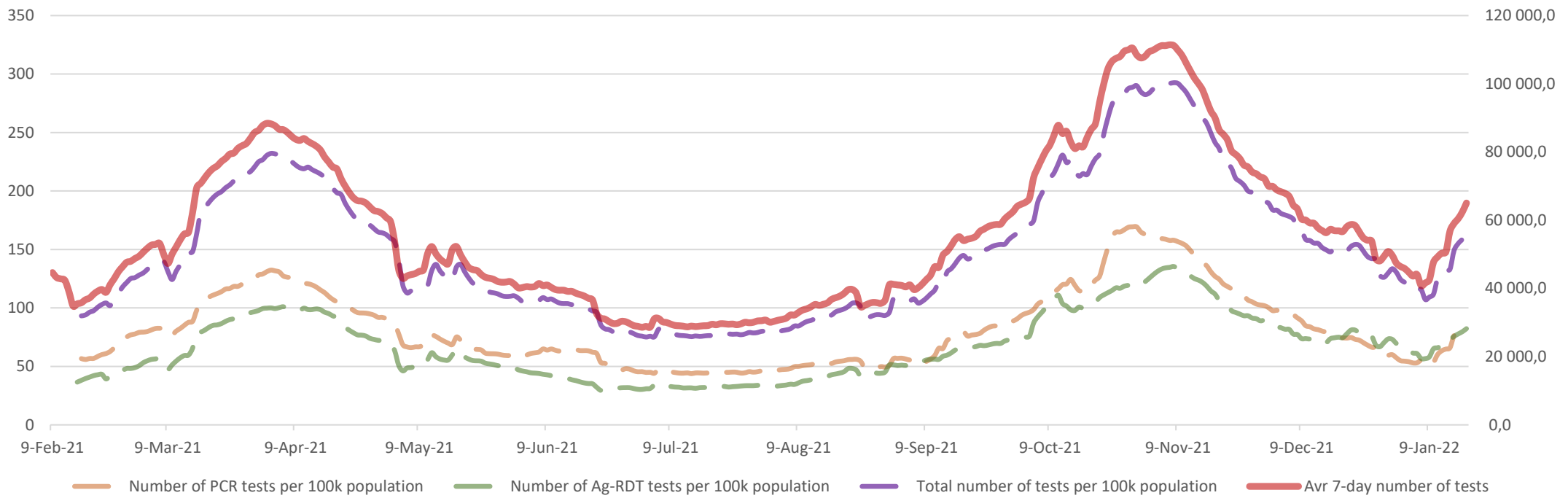

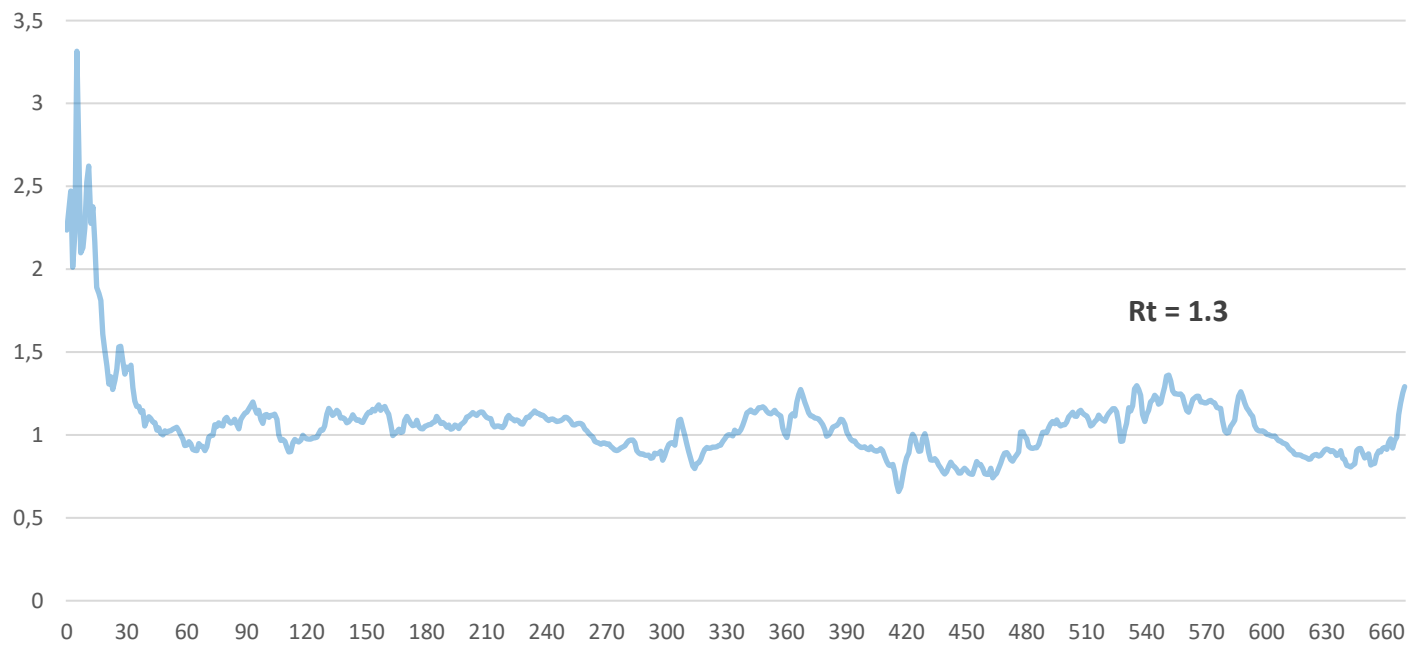
