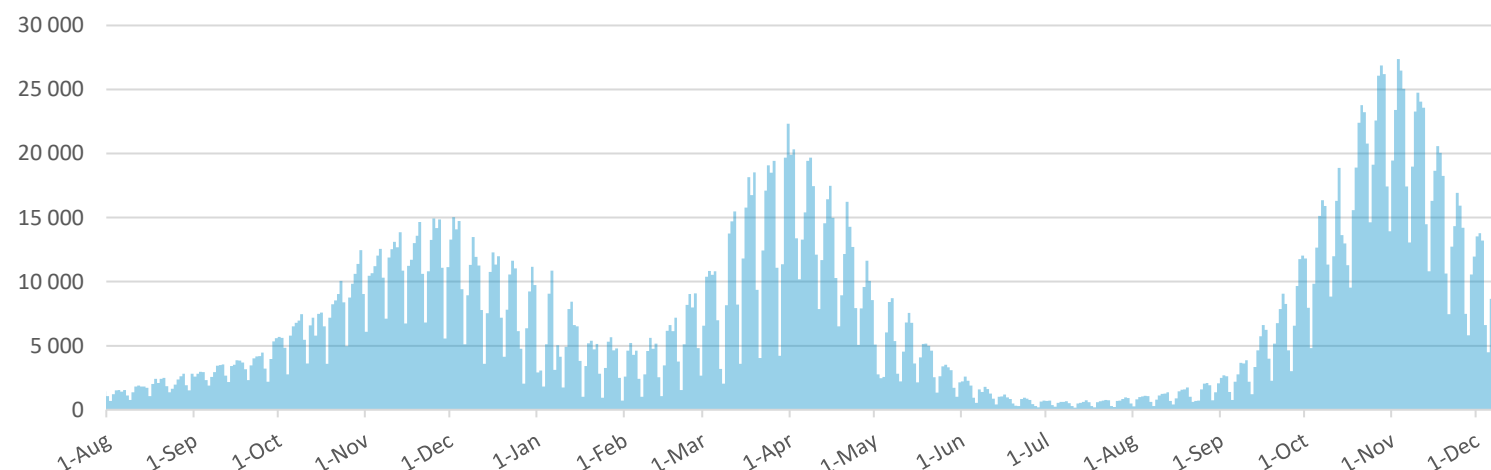

Confirmed cases by the date of reporting



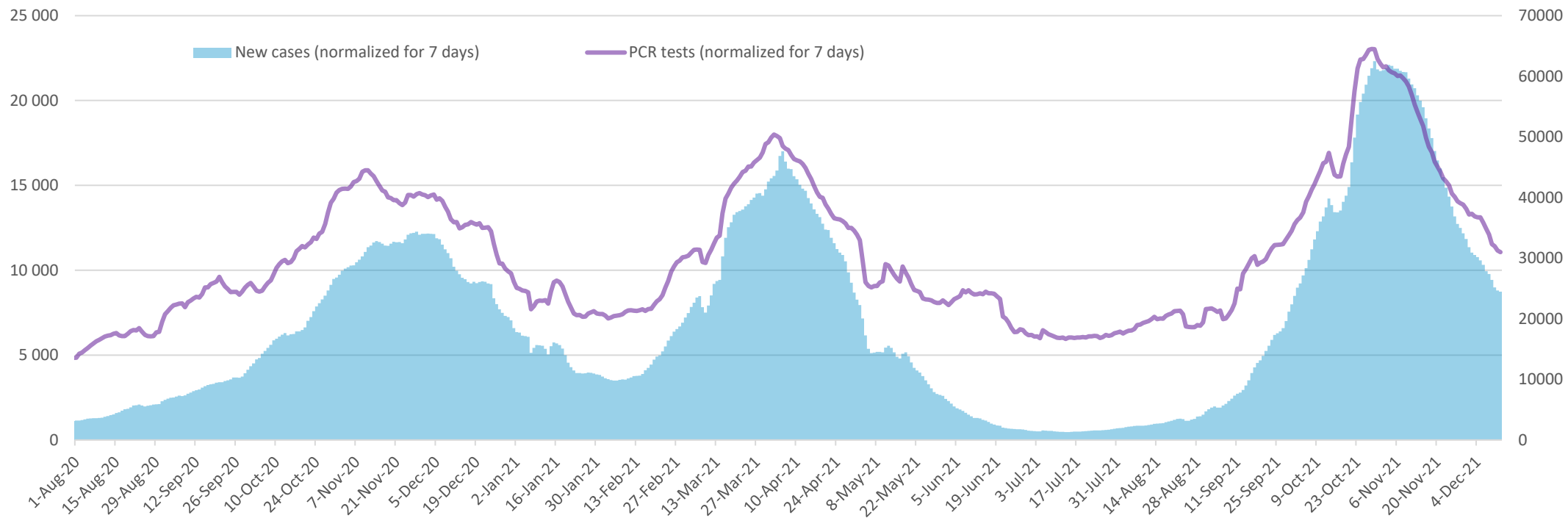

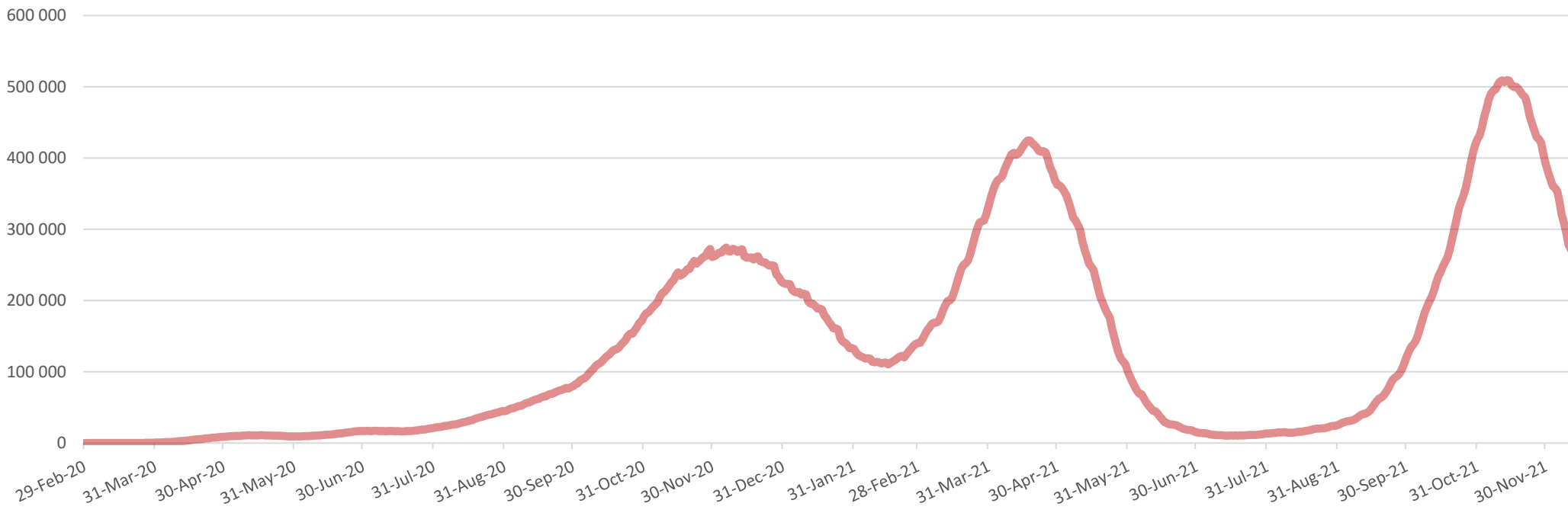

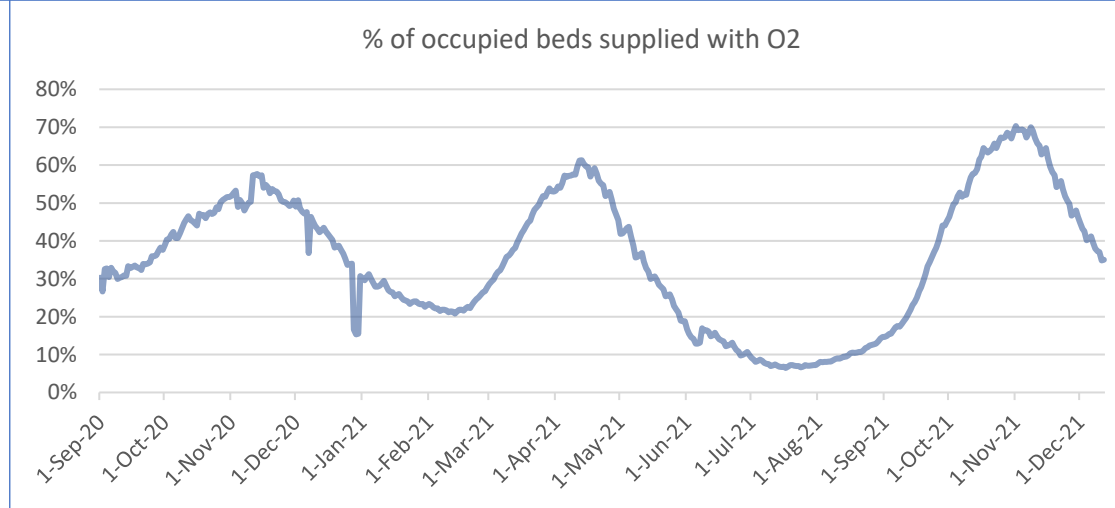
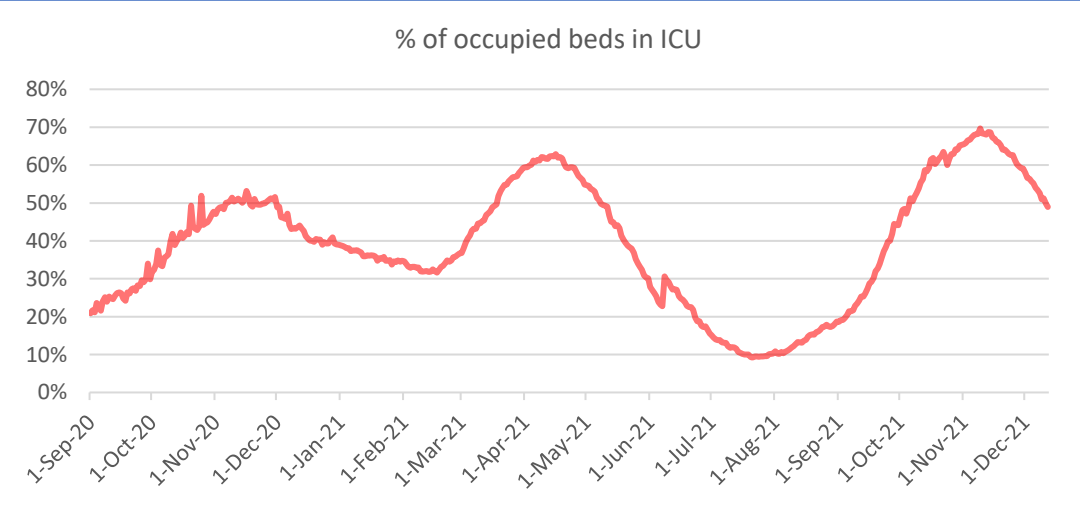
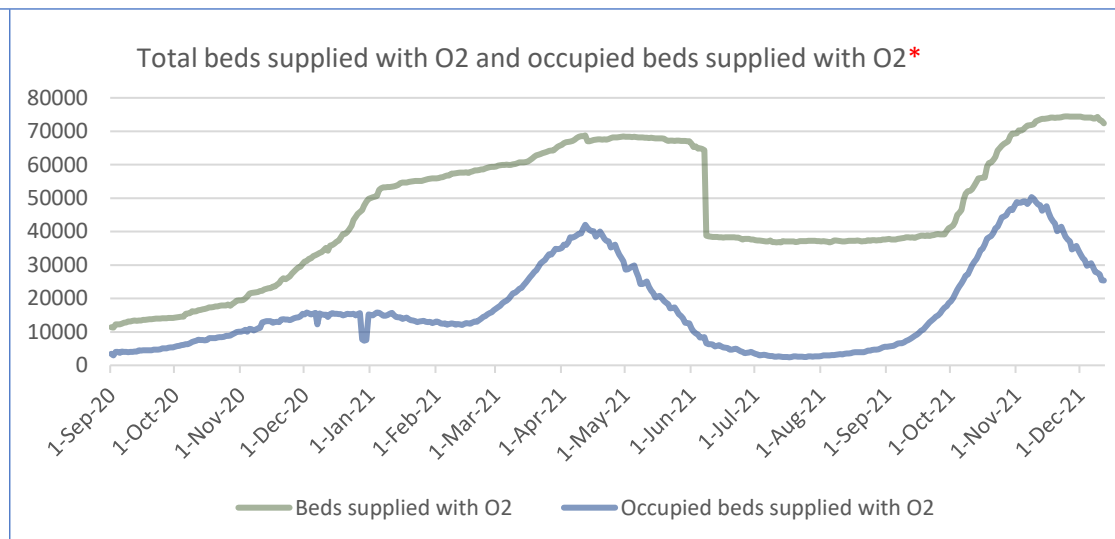
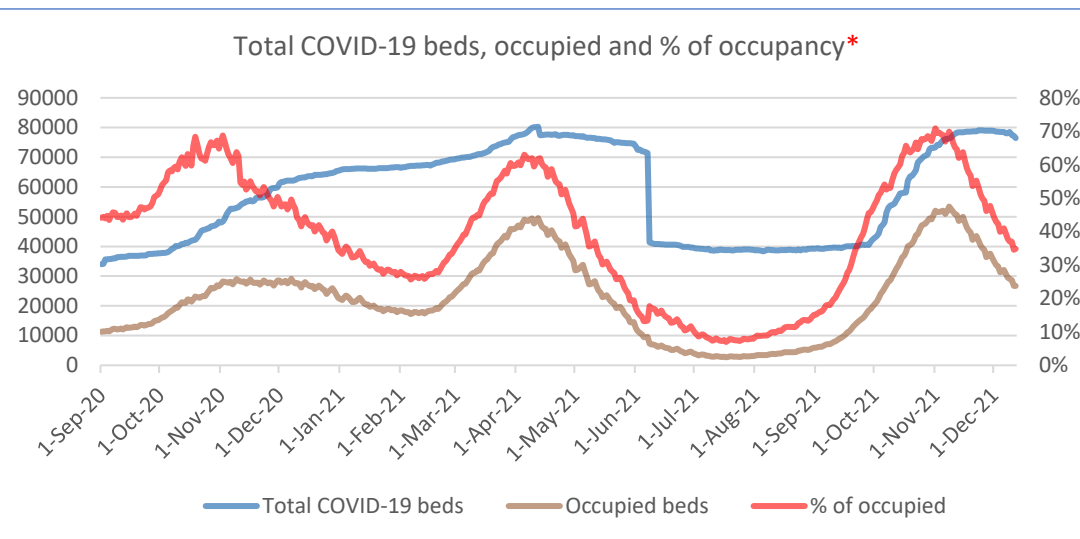
Comparison of number of daily confirmed cases and daily PCR tests (normalized for 7 days)

- Kirovograd region – 54%
- Zakarpattia region – 52.6%

Share of beds occupied by suspected and confirmed cases in the same regions:

- Kirovograd region – 55.1%
- Zakarpattia region – 53.2%

Share of beds occupied in ICU:

- Kirovograd region – 79.8%
- Zakarpattia region – 69.4%

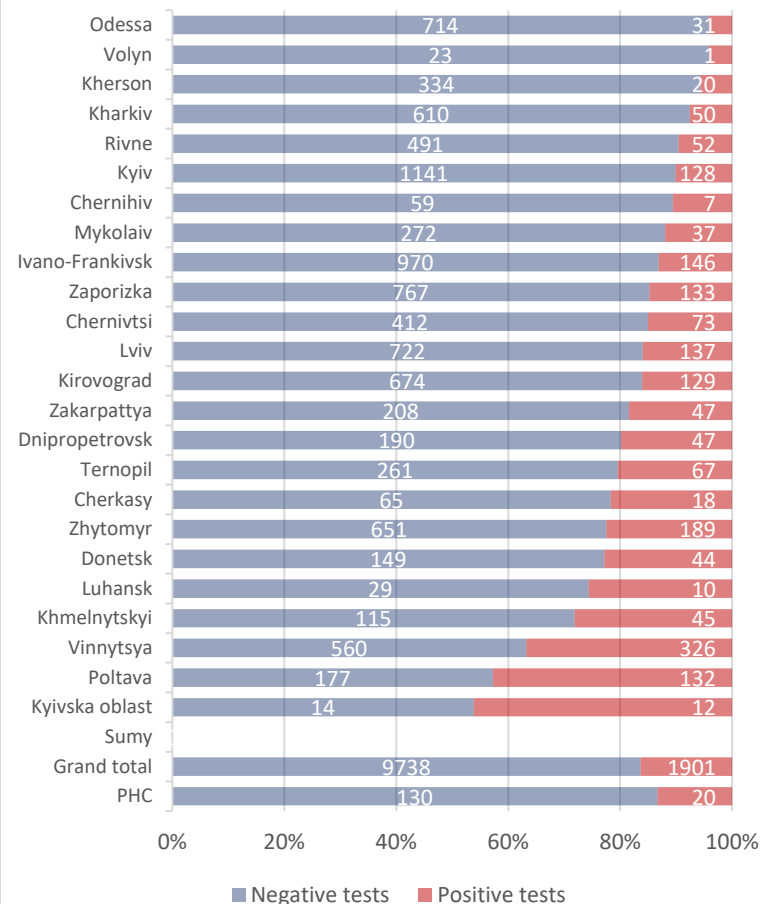

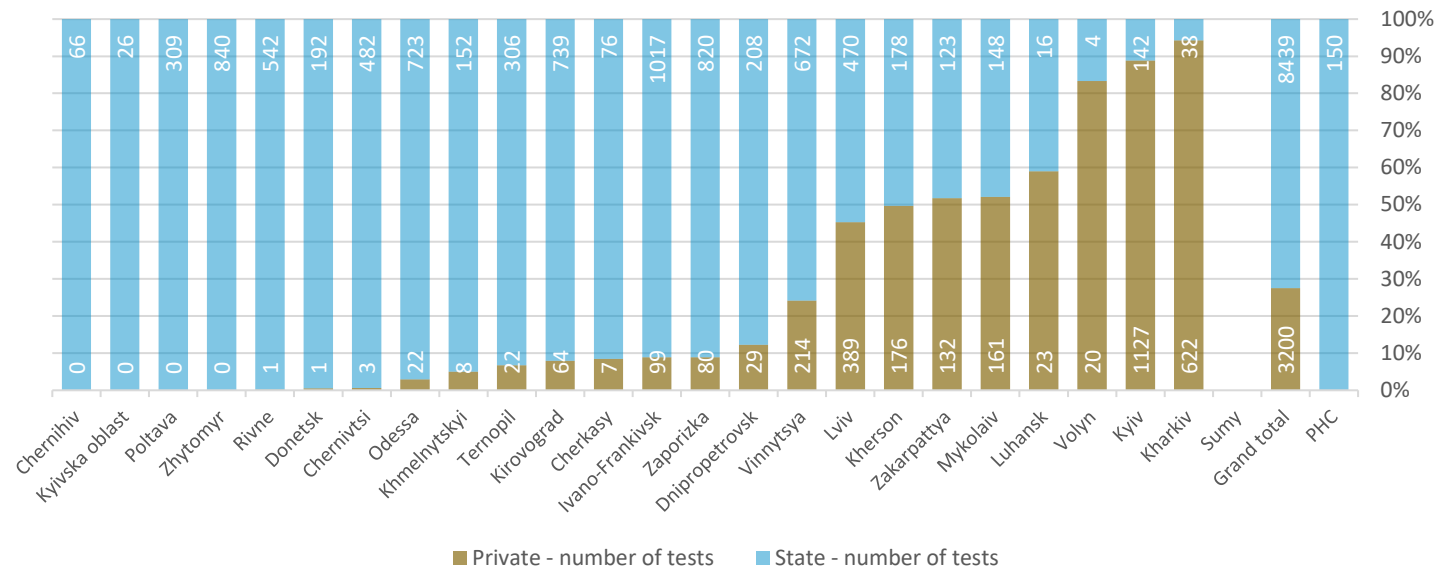

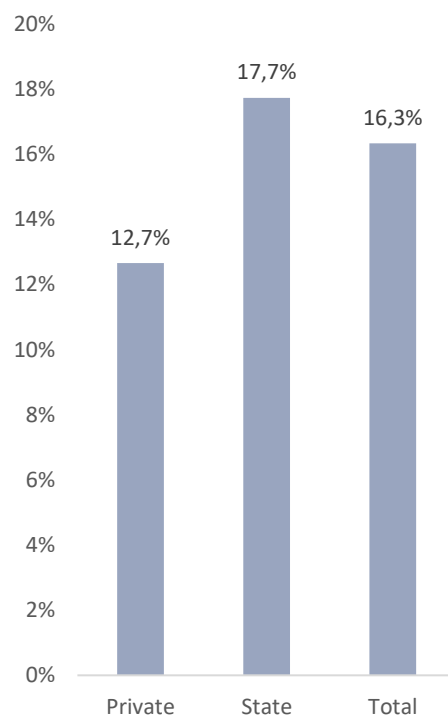
Number of positive* and negative results



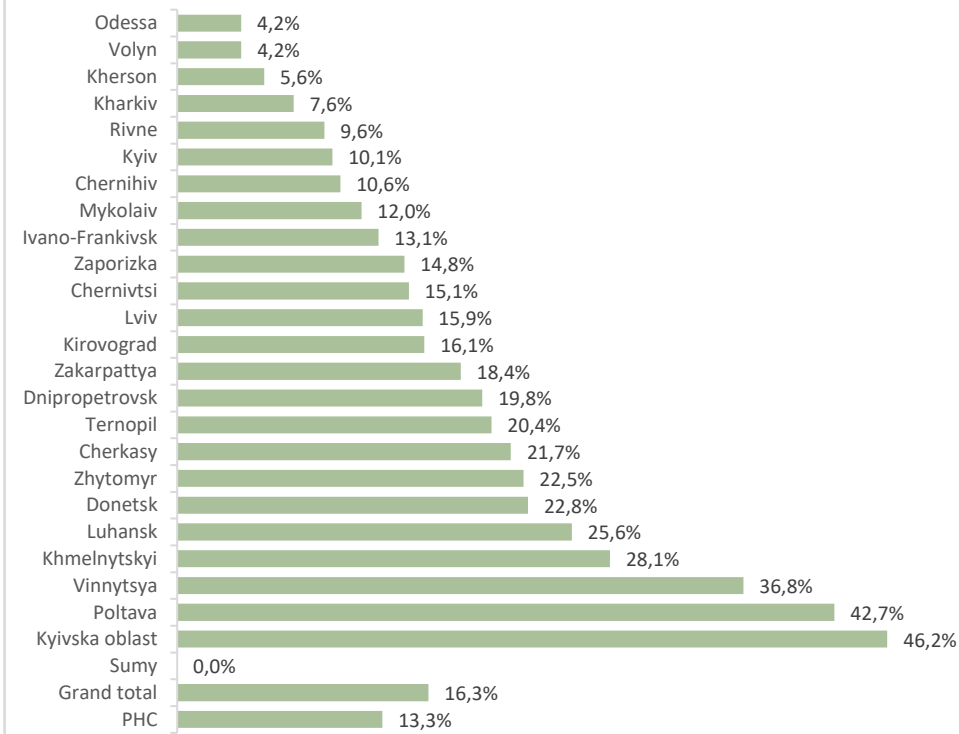
Share of tests done in private and state labs



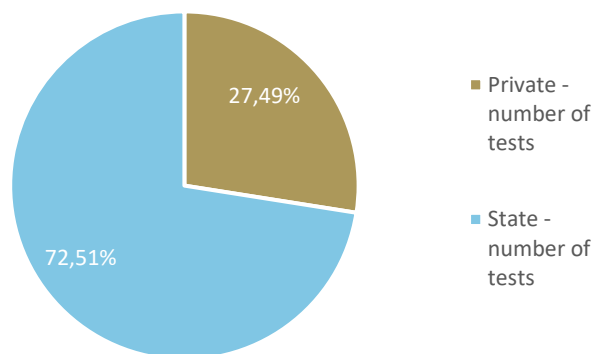
Positivity rate in private and state labs



Percent of positive result

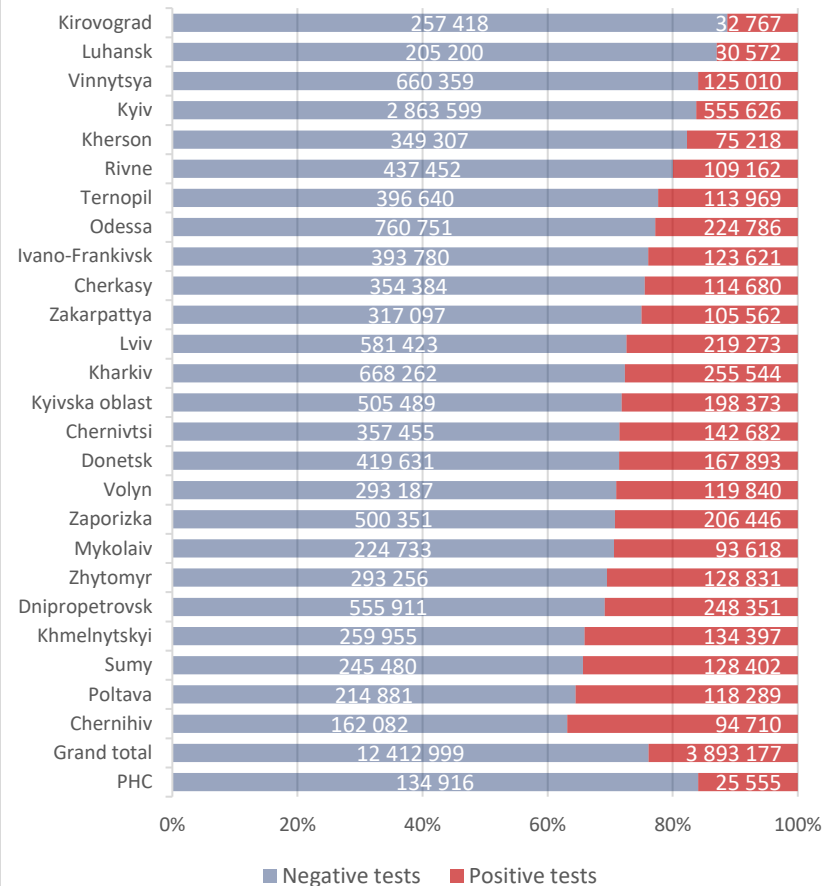

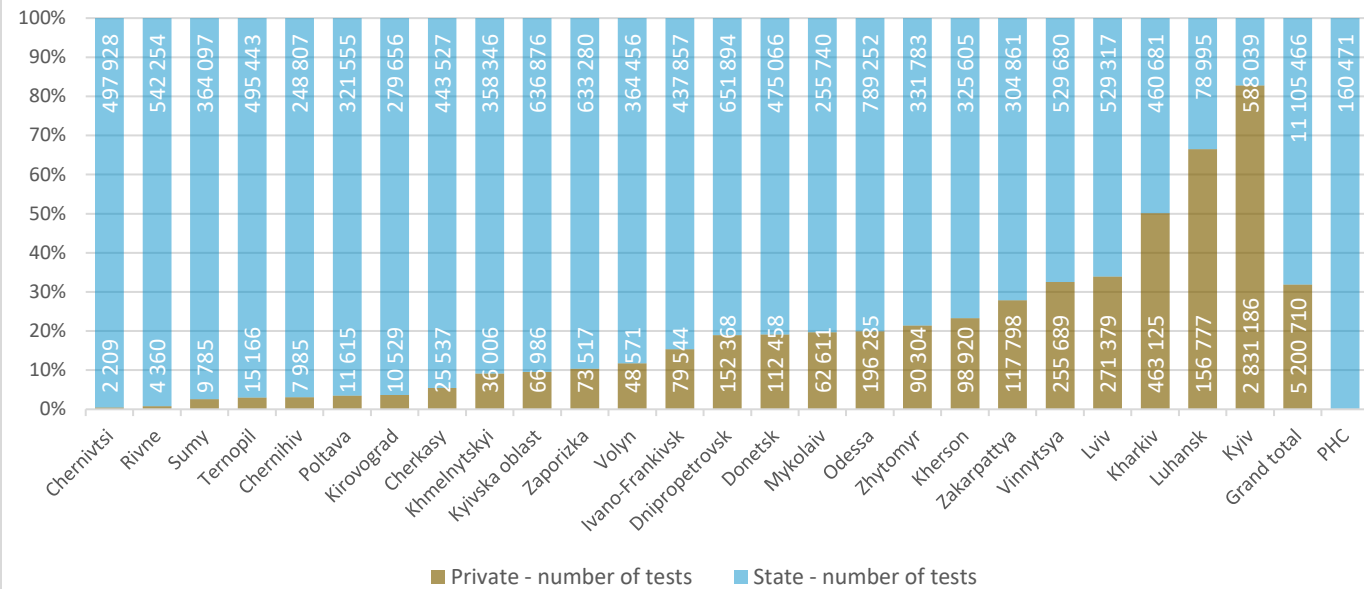

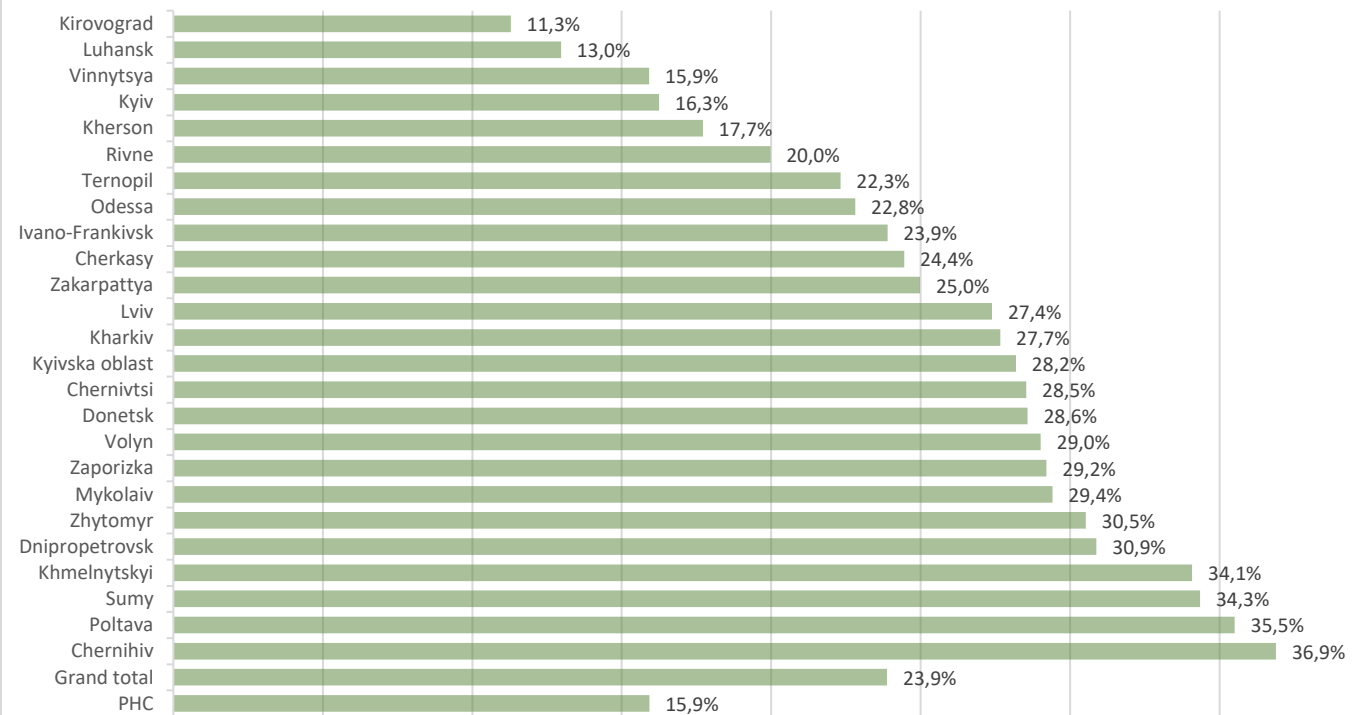

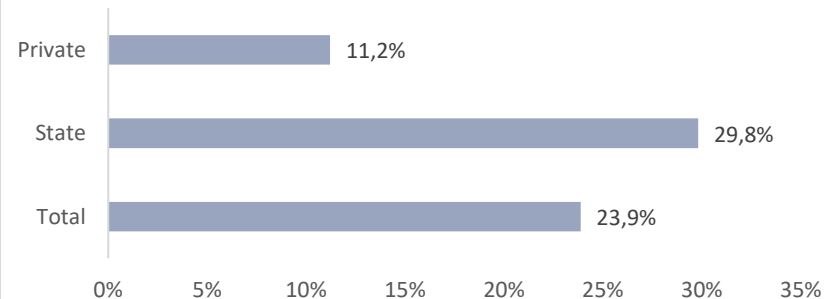
Share of tests done in private and state labs



Percent of positive result



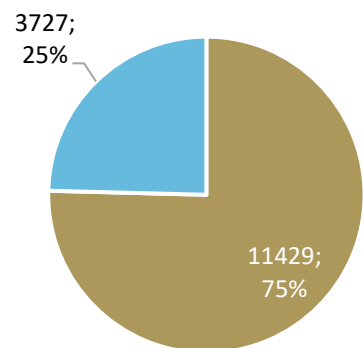

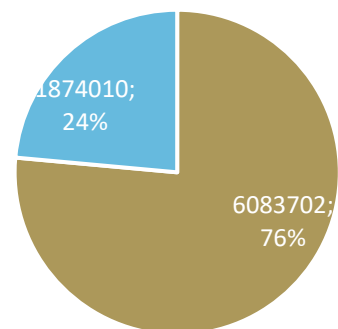

Daily share of tests done in laboratories and health facilities



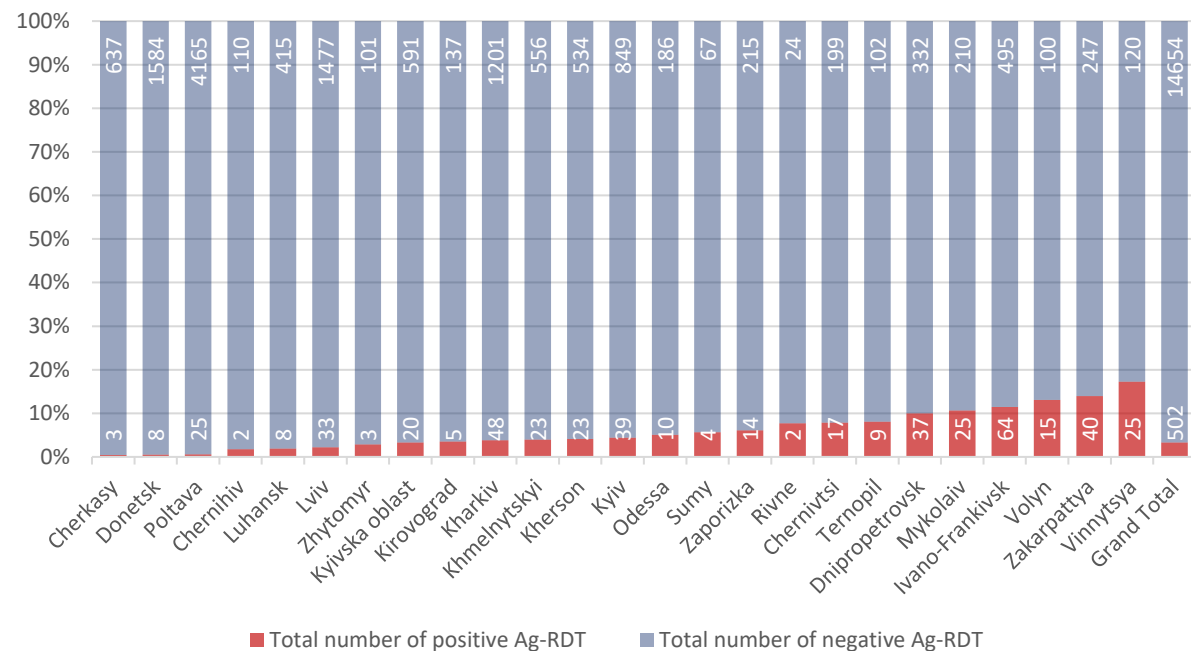

Cumulative share of tests done in laboratories and health facilities

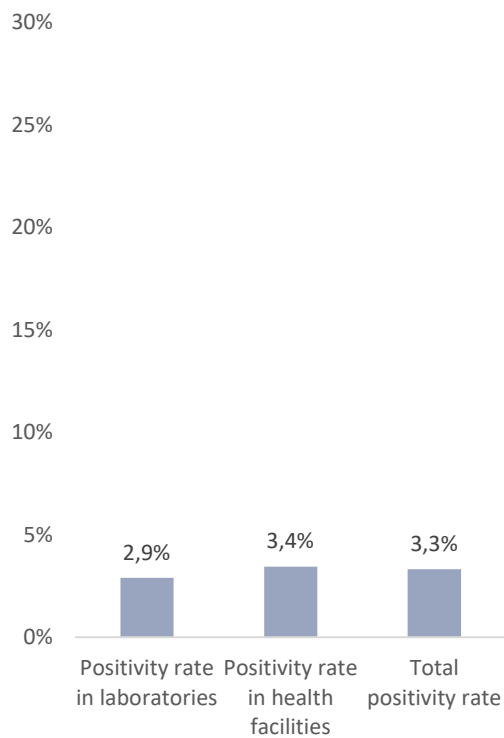

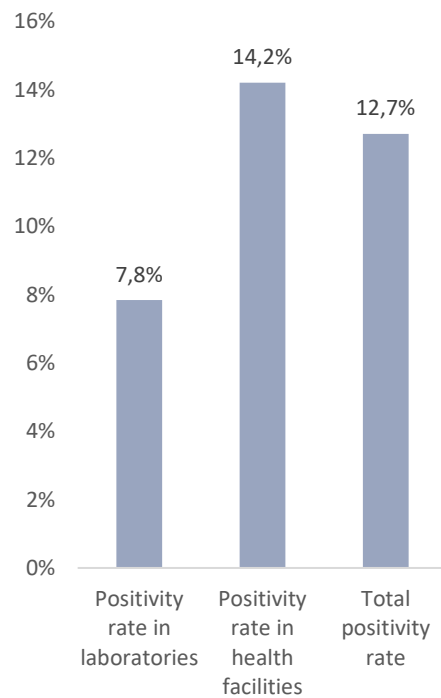
Daily share of positive and negative results



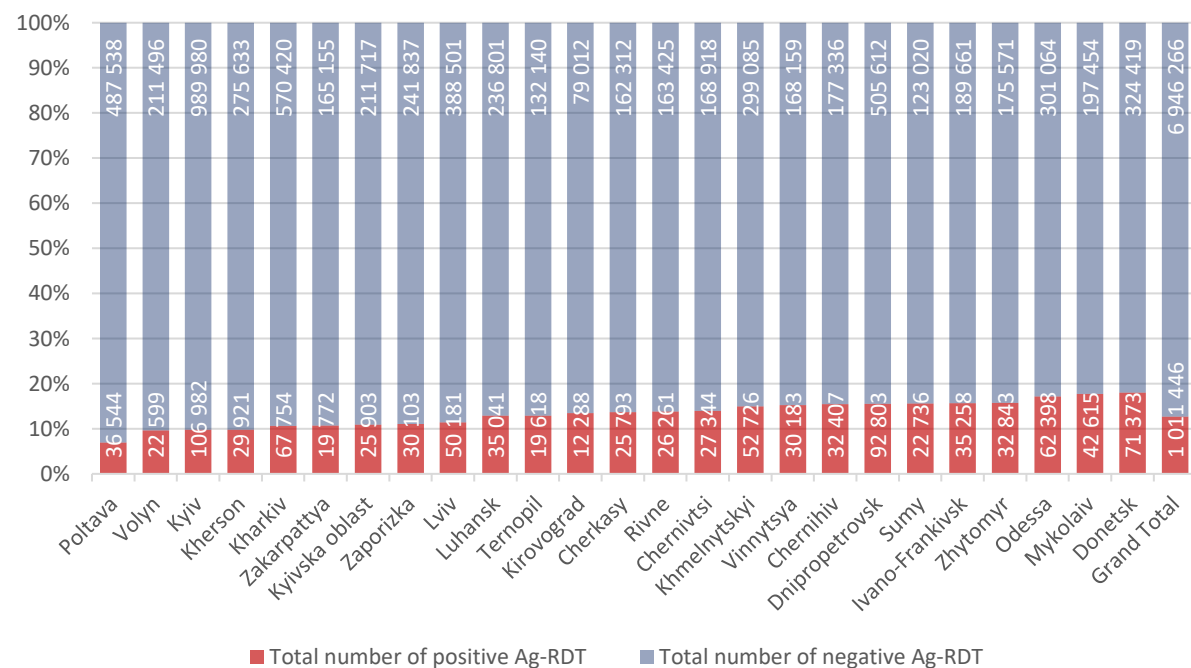
Daily positivity rate in laboratories and health facilities



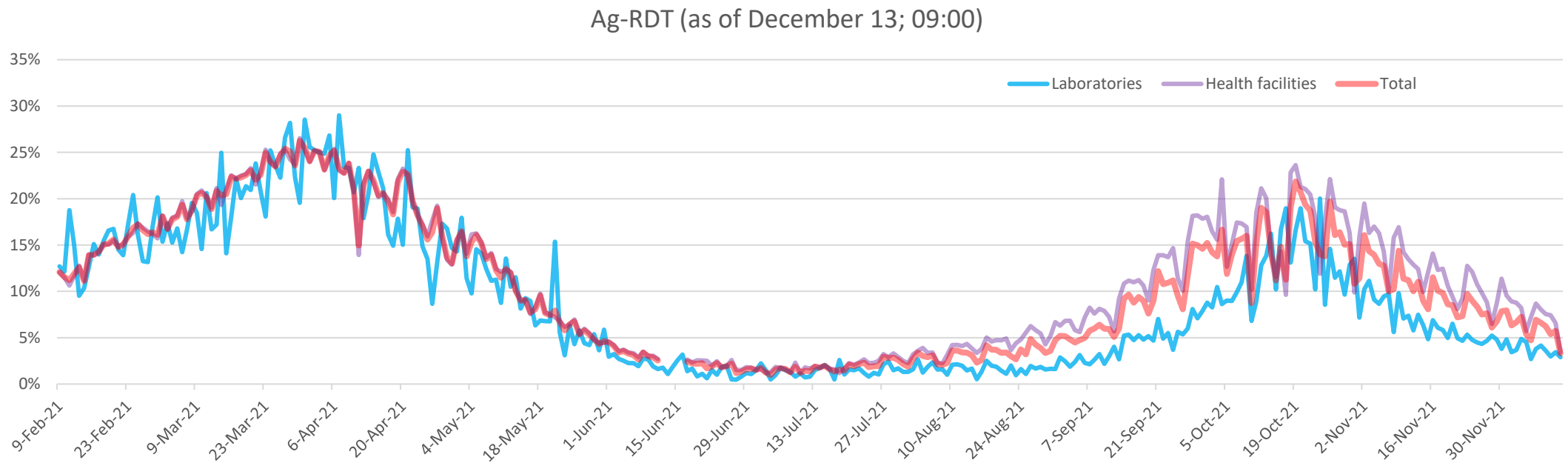
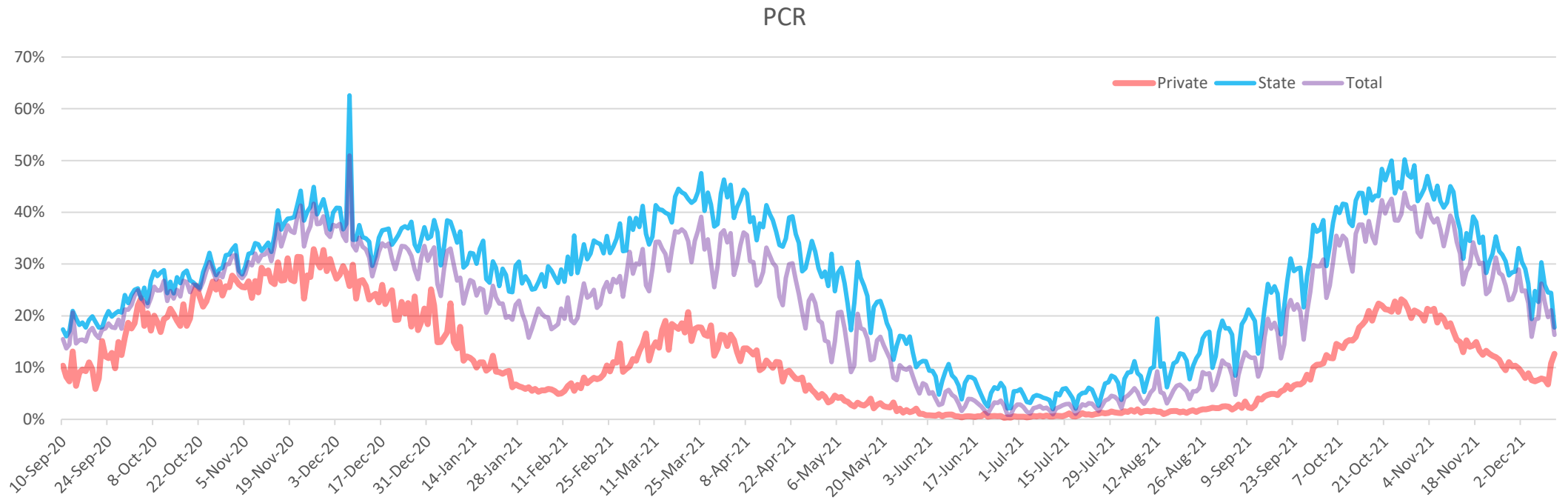
Cumulative positivity rate in laboratories and health facilities



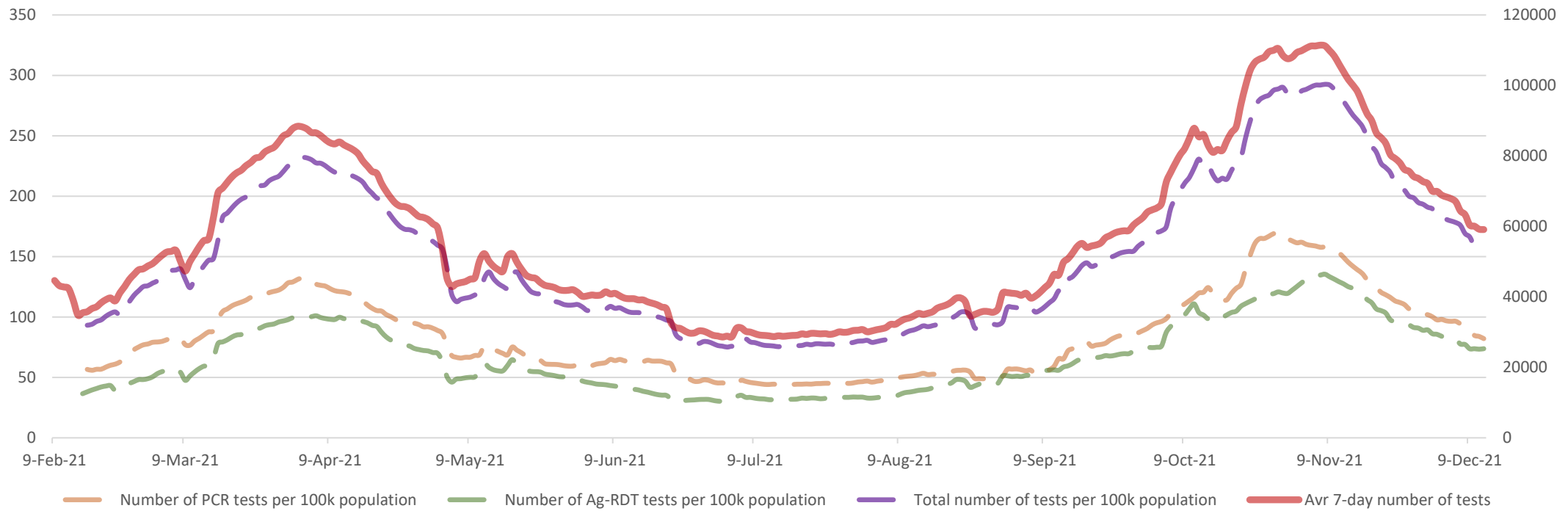
Cumulative share of positive and negative results



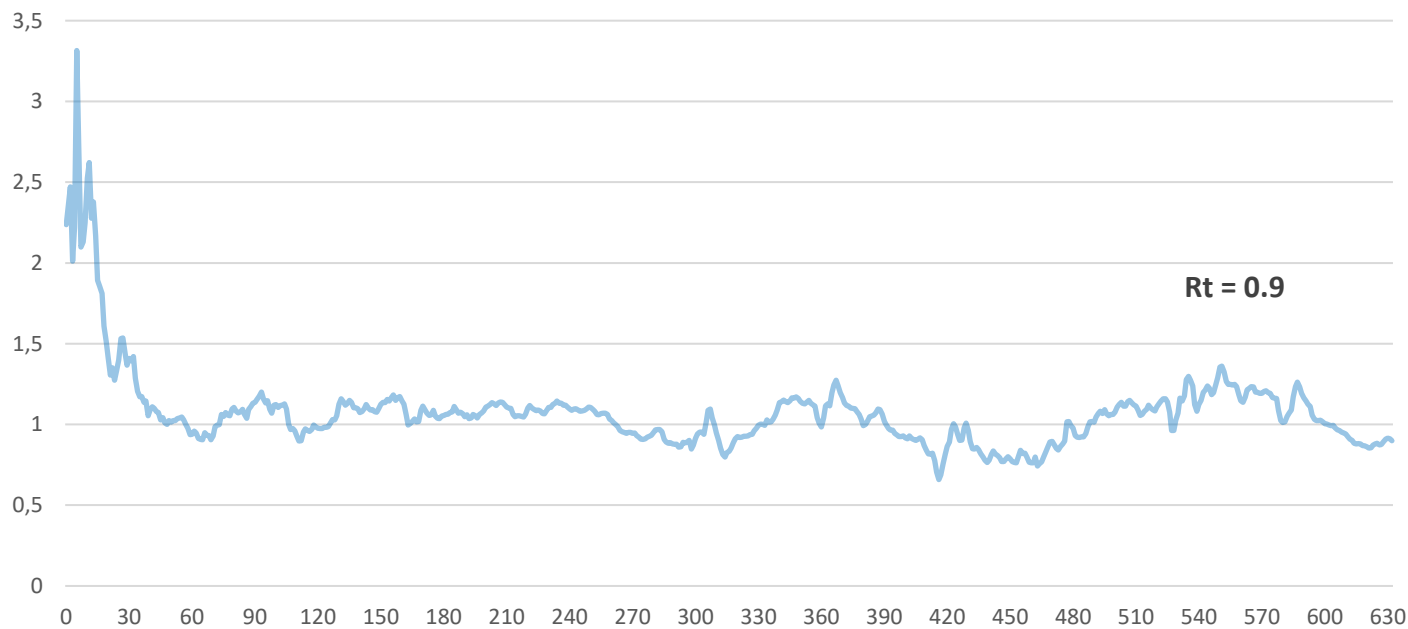
Trend in test positivity rate
