Improving cause-of-death statistics

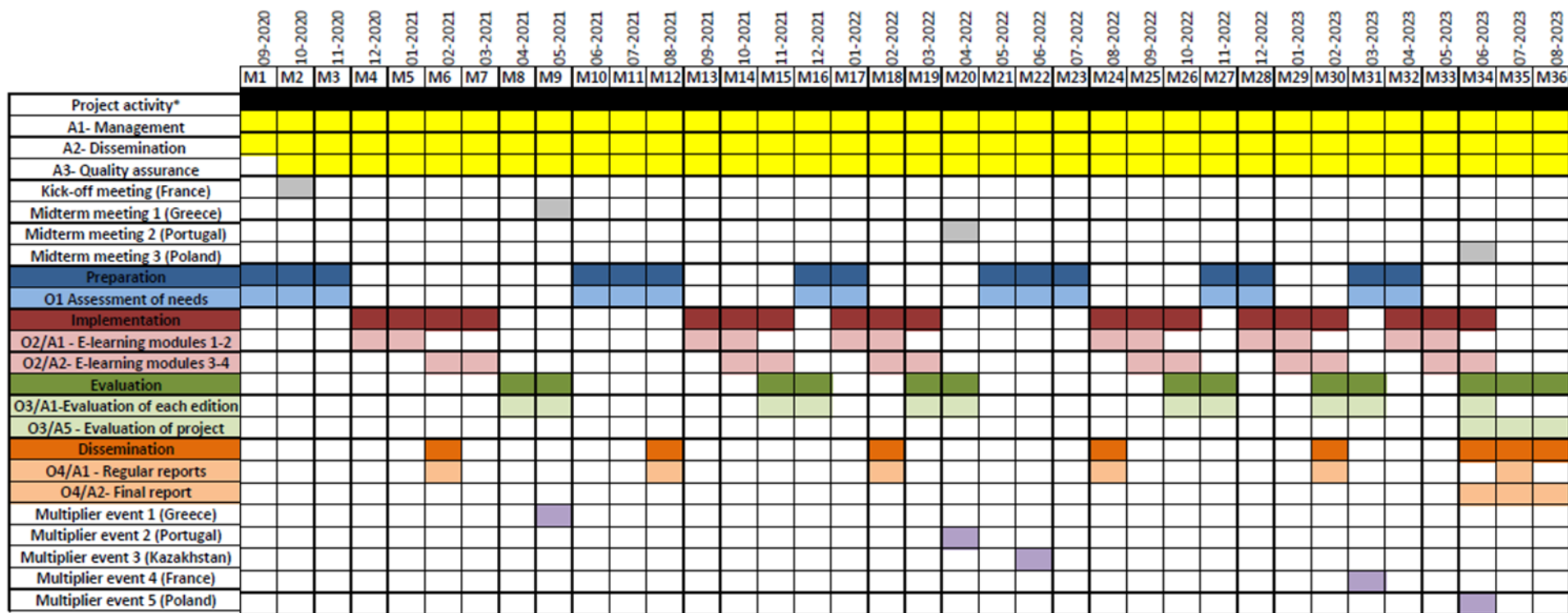
- tackling skills and competences gaps in certification causes of death and co-existing diseases;

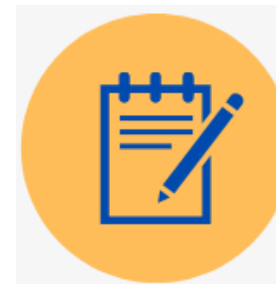
