## **Instructions for Authors**

### **Article length**

Articles should not exceed 20,000 characters (2,500–3,000 words), including tables, figures, abstract, and spaces. Each column of the bulletin corresponds to 3,000 characters. A small figure with a note to interpreting it corresponds to 1,000 characters (a third of a column), a medium-size figure to 1,500 characters, and a large figure to 2,000 characters. Table sizes are estimated the same way.

### **Figures**

Figures are preferred over tables (especially large ones), though tables can be included. Upon acceptance of the manuscript, figures must be provided in Excel or vector format (.eps or .svg) so that they can be reworked by the bulletin's graphic designer and translated into English. Figures with dotted lines or dashes should be avoided in favour of continuous lines.

### **References**

Articles should have a maximum of five or six references, except in special cases. Web links and DOIs must be indicated, if available.

### **Vocabulary and style**

The text must be educational. It should be understandable by a non-specialist readership, so please refrain from using technical words (or use them sparingly). To get an idea of the style, you might wish to consult past issues: <https://www.ined.fr/fr/publications/population-et-societes/>

### **Peer review process**

Articles eligible for review are reviewed anonymously by outside experts and members of the Editorial Board. The final decision is made by the Editorial Board and approved by the Director of Publications.

### **Criteria**

- Relevance of the subject matter
- Originality and importance of the research question; contribution to knowledge. A submission can be a synopsis of a scientific article previously published by the author.
- Rigorous and well-articulated methodology, which may be developed in a previously published article or in online supplementary material.
- Accurate presentation of results and sources
- Quality of writing, clarity
