

## **Getting annual statistics on foreign migration inflows in France (metropolitan area)**

Since 1994 INED is producing a new time series on foreign migration inflows in France (including EU citizens) complying with the international definition related to the long-term migration (stay of at least one year).

These statistics are available in various tables providing :

- A) A brief overview of annual trends on migration flows and their main characteristics for the most recent year (2005)

- B) An annual presentation of the characteristics of the migration flows according to the variables available (country of citizenship, sex, age, ground for issuing the residence permit):

Everyone may download - under a pdf format and for a given year since 1994 - two types of files :

(1) a first set of 9 synthetic tables with an intermediate level of details : 25 most frequent countries of citizenship, aggregation by continent or other geographical areas, ...

(2) a second set of 9 tables as much detailed as possible distributing about 100 countries of citizenship by sex, age and reason for issue.
