



## PHD RECEPTION AU FIL DE L'EAU (Funding outside Ined)

### **Application deposit**

All the forms (applicant and incoming) and documents to provide are to be sent by email to the following address : [info-doctorants@ined.fr](mailto:info-doctorants@ined.fr)

*Please precise "PhD reception with an outside funding" as the object of the email.*

### **Eligibility in order to apply**

Every applicant must take notice of *la Politique d'accueil de l'Ined* and of *la Charte des doctorants*.

The applicant must fulfil three criteria:

- Being a Master 2 holder or an equivalent diploma allowing to register in a French or a foreign university in a PhD programme, in courses related to population sciences.
- Being registered in **the first year of** a PhD in a French or foreign institution during the ongoing academic year.
- Being directed or co-directed by an Ined searcher.
- No age nor nationality criteria are required.



## **Information and compulsory documents of the application file**

All the information and documents are to be in French and/or in English.

In order to build up a complete file, the applicant shall provide the following pieces :

1. The applicant form.
2. The supervisor(s) form(s) :

**The applicant must provide the form to each of his supervisors and then return it with the file at : [info-doctorants@ined.fr](mailto:info-doctorants@ined.fr)**

3. The following documents :

- Curriculum vitae
- Cover letter
- Transcript of marks of the Master 2 or equivalent diploma
- Master 2 or equivalent diploma's essay (in pdf)
- Master 2 or equivalent diploma's viva report  
***If the applicant does not have it, he has to deliver an attestation of the supervisor of the formation explaining that he is unable to give the viva report and the reason why***
- Thesis project with a maximum of five pages. It must include :
  - The scientific context of the problematic, showing its importance and originality using bibliographic elements
  - The hypotheses and goals of the research
  - Methodology : sources of the data, data collection, statistic methods that are used
  - Main results expected
  - Plan and calendar of work
- Certificate of financing.
